We have four jurisdictions that we're conducting the election for. Roughly, at least portions of 43 precincts are involved in Franklin County with the elections.

what the minimum paper ballot allocation would be for this election, which includes 15 percent of the registered voters for any voters who opt to vote a paper ballot, plus then the number of provisionals cast in a like election in the past four years.

And I actually went back further to get that information plus five percent of that number. So the numbers that are presented before you are some of those two numbers and rounded to a pad of 25 ballots for ease of auditing post-election.

We've decided to stick with the numbers of the allocations that we've done in the past. So the machines are based on one machine for every 243 active voters in the location with no less than three machines being assigned. Those are the ballot marking devices. The counting devices, the DS200s, for every nine machines there is one DS200 for each nine in increments up with us allocating no more than two to any location this election. And the poll pads are based on one poll pad for every 750 total voters in the location, with no less than three of those being assigned. DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Thank you,

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In both of those districts we have less than 200 registered voters. Ohio Revised Code Section 3503.01(B) permits that if a portion of a precinct is all that is involved in an election that we are permitted to work with the most populous county or the county with an adjacent precinct to temporarily reassign those voters to that county in order to avoid us having to open up a location for that few voters. So that we would be assigning 198 voters in Madison-Plains Local School District to a location just outside of London, to the Madison-Plains Intermediate School gym, and we would be assigning 22 voters from the Jonathan Alder Local School District to the Jonathan Alder High School gym that is in a precinct adjacent in Madison County as well.

So we're asking that you allow for us the permission -- the ability to work with Madison County in reassigning these voters and having Madison County conduct those elections for us.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Carla, is it

fair to say that we have at least had initial conversation with Madison County Board of Elections and they're amenable to this if passed by the Board?

MS. PATTON: Yes. I've had discussions with Abby Metheney over there, who is the Director. And this is a common practice between us and Madison County in the past, as these school districts are known for the special elections. And so it's been a common practice for us to reassign our voters in the past.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Thank you.

Are there any questions for Carla regarding the reassignment of voters to Madison County?

MEMBER SEXTON: If none, -- Michael Sexton -- I move that the Board authorize the Director and Deputy Director to request that the Madison County Board of Elections accept the temporary reassignment of voters within the Madison-Plains Local District and the Jonathan Alder Local School District to adjacent precincts within Madison County pursuant to ORC 3503.01(B) for the purpose of voting in the May 4th, 2021 Special Election.
