Registration Ends Tomorrow for General Election

(Columbus) Franklin County residents have one more day to register in person or by mail for the Nov. 4, 2008 general election.

The board of elections, located at 280 East Broad Street, will be open from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. tomorrow, Monday, Oct. 6, to accept new and updated voter registration forms and have a drive up container available in the board's parking lot so drivers can drop completed forms from their cars. Registration and absentee voting also will be available to county residents at Veterans Memorial, located at 300 West Broad Street, from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. tomorrow. Mailed registrations must carry tomorrow's postmark.

Residents are urged to visit our Web site at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> to determine if they are properly registered. They should update their address if they've moved recently and may need to re-register if they haven't voted since 2000, changed their name or were jailed for a felony and have since been released.

Registration forms may be downloaded from the Web site. It also is possible to register or drop completed forms at the following locations:

- Franklin County Treasurer's Office
- Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles offices
- Ohio Secretary of State's Office
- Public libraries
- Public high schools and vocational schools
- Designated agencies providing public assistance and disability programs

Registration is open to U.S. citizens living in Franklin County thirty days before the election who will be at least 18 years old by Nov. 4. More than 808,000 county residents are registered for the general election.
