## **General Election Tomorrow**

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections projects more than 20 percent of the county's 842,000 registered voters will turn out for tomorrow's general election.

Three proposed amendments to the state constitution, a children's services levy and candidates for judge will appear on all ballots throughout the county. Local ballots will include candidates for municipal offices and school board in addition to levies for schools, police and fire protection. A number of liquor options will be voted on locally as well. Voters in Whitehall will decide whether to recall a member of city council.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Voters are reminded to bring photo identification to the polls such as their Ohio driver's license, military I.D. or other documents such as pay stubs or utility bills with the voter's name and current address.

Voters are encouraged to visit the board's Web site <a href="http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov">http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</a> before Election Day to inspect their sample ballot and find their polling location. Results will be posted on the site after the polls close on election night and will be updated throughout the evening.
