## CANDIDATES CERTIFIED FOR MAY PRIMARY

**(Columbus)** The Franklin County Board of Elections certified candidates and issues for the May 4, 2010 primary election today.

Voters will consider nominees for federal, state and local offices. There will be two statewide issues on the ballot including the relocation of a proposed gambling casino in Columbus. Suburban ballots will carry local tax questions and liquor options. More than 800,000 residents are registered to vote in Franklin County. First time registrants and others who need to update their home address or file a change of name have until April 5 to register for the primary.
