## **Registration Ends Today for Primary**

**(Columbus)** This is the last day voters may register by mail or in person for the May 3, 2011 primary election.

The board of elections will be open until 9 p.m. for voters to register or to drop off their completed registration forms. Registrations by mail also are acceptable if postmarked by today.

Registration forms are available at the board of elections, on the Web <a href="http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov">http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</a> and at the following locations:

- Franklin County Treasurer's Office
- Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Offices
- Ohio Secretary of State's Office
- Public high schools or vocational schools
- Public libraries
- Designated agencies including colleges and universities providing public assistance and disability programs

Registrants will need to provide their Ohio drivers license number or the last four digits of their Social Security number if applying in person. Those who register by mail will need to provide one of the following: a copy of a photo identification, military identification, utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government document other than a document from the board of elections.

Registration is open to U.S. citizens who reside in Franklin County and who will be 18 or older by the Nov. 8 general election. Voters as young as 17 may register to vote and cast ballots for candidates, but not issues in the primary.
