## **Special Election Absentee Voting Begins Thursday**

**(Columbus)** Absentee voting for the Feb. 4 special election begins this Thursday, Jan. 2. There will be one issue on the ballot-a proposed municipal income tax increase in the Village of Minerva Park. More than 1,000 voters are eligible for the election.

In- person absentee voting will be held weekdays at the Franklin County Board of Elections at the following times:

- Weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Jan. 2 to Jan. 31.
- Saturday, Feb. 1 from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

## <u>Please note: There will be no voting on Monday, Jan. 20 when the board of elections will be closed for Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.</u>

Voters must request an absentee ballot to receive one in this election. Applications are available at public libraries, at the board of elections, on the <u>Web</u> or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3100 or (614) 525-3470.

Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Feb. 3 and received by the board of elections by Feb. 14 to count.

Voters must be registered by Jan. 6 to be eligible for this election.
