## Voters Who've Moved Urged to Update Address with Board of Elections

(Columbus) Franklin County voters are urged to watch their mailbox if they have moved within the past year or haven't voted since 2012. They can expect a letter from the board of elections within a few days asking them to update their voting address.

The mailing is required under the National Voter Registration Act more commonly known as "Motor Voter." It attempts to keep voter registration records current with information available from driver licenses. Approximately 75,000 of the county's 798,000 registered voters will be contacted.

The notice will be sent to the latest address on file with the board of elections-to a new address if the post office has one-or to a forwarding address when one is available. The mailing will include a postage paid return envelope so voters can register a new address by mail. They may also update their address online at <a href="https://www.MyOhioVote.com">www.MyOhioVote.com</a>

Voters who return a notice to confirm they still live at the address where they are registered will remain "active" voters. Those who do not respond will be listed as "inactive" and have their registration canceled in 2018 unless they update their address or vote in the meantime. Registrations will be canceled for voters who report a new permanent address outside Ohio.
