Registration Ends for Primary Election Tonight

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters that registration for the May 5 primary/special election ends tonight. The board of elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, will remain open until 9:00 p.m. for voters to register or deliver their completed forms to our office.

Registrations by mail are acceptable if they are postmarked by today. Registration forms are available at our office, on the Web at <u>http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</u> or at the following locations:

- Franklin County Treasurer's Office
- Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Offices
- Ohio Secretary of State's Office
- Public high schools or vocational schools
- Designated agencies including colleges and universities providing public assistance and disability programs

Registrants will need to provide the last four digits of their Social Security number or their Ohio driver license number if they register in person. Those who register by mail and do not provide that identification will need to submit one of the following: a copy of their photo identification, utility bill, bank statement, pay stub or government document other than one from the board of elections.

Registration is open to U.S. citizens who live in Franklin County and who will be 18 or older by the Nov. 3 general election. Voters as young as 17 may register and vote for candidates, but not issues in the primary.
