## **Final Week of Absentee Voting Underway**

(Columbus) The final week of absentee voting for the Nov. 3 general election began this morning.

The latest numbers show 29,690 requesting absentee ballots in Franklin County. The total includes 3, 320 voting at the board of elections with 398 voting in-person on Friday for the highest one day total so far.

Early voting expands this week with additional weekday and weekend hours and will run at the following times:

- Today through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, Oct. 31 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, Nov. 1 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, Nov. 2 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Voters have until noon Saturday to request an absentee ballot by mail. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than Nov. 2. Ballots returned in- person must arrive at the board of elections before the polls close on Election Day.

## Please note: absentee ballots will not be accepted at any other Election Day voting location.

Local polling places will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Voters can find their polling location and see the issues on their ballot by checking the Sample Ballot link on our Web site.
