In-Person Absentee Voting Ends Tomorrow

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters they have one more day to vote early in-person for the March 15, 2016 primary election. Our early vote center, located at the board of elections, will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. tomorrow.

Totals as of this morning show over 41,000 had requested absentee ballots so far including some 13,000 voting early in-person compared to more than 30,000 total absentee votes cast for the most recent presidential primary in 2012.

Important Deadlines to Remember:

Voted absentee ballots must be postmarked no later than tomorrow, March 14, and arrive at the board of elections by March 25 to count in this election.

Absentee ballots may be dropped off at the board of elections until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Please note that they will not be accepted at any other polling location open on Tuesday.

Nearly 800,000 voters in Franklin County are eligible for this election. Local polling places will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
