## Absentee Voting Begins One Week from Today on October 10th

**(Columbus)** Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins one week from today on Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup> for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election. To date over 80,000 absentee ballot applications have been returned to the Franklin County Board of Elections. Those ballots will be mailed on October 10<sup>th</sup>.

In-person early voting will run from Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 through Monday, November 5th, 2018 and take place at the Board of Elections located at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus at the following times:

- Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup> to Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> (Weekdays) 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup> 8:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, October 29<sup>th</sup> to Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> 8:00 a.m. 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> 8:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, November 4<sup>th</sup> 1:00 p.m. 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup> 8:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m.
