Early Absentee Voting for May 7 Primary Election Begins Tomorrow

(Columbus) Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins tomorrow for the May 7, 2019 Primary Election. In-person early voting will run from Tuesday, April 9, 2019 through Monday, May 6, 2019 and take place at the Franklin County Board of Elections located at 1700 Morse Road at the following times:

Weekdays, April 9 through April 26 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Final week, April 29 through May 3 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, May 4 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Sunday, May 5 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Monday, May 6 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Registered voters can view their sample ballot by visiting our website at http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov.

Voters planning to cast a ballot by mail must request one by May 4. Applications are available online at http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov, at public libraries or by calling the Board of Elections at (614) 525-3470.
