## **Voting Locations in Schools, Libraries, and Recreation Centers**

(Columbus) The Board of Elections wants to reassure voters that <u>ALL</u> voting locations housed in schools, libraries, and recreation centers throughout Franklin County will be <u>OPEN</u> Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020, for voters to cast ballots. Polls will open at 6:30 a.m. and will not close until 7:30 p.m. Any voter in line at 7:30 p.m. at any voting location will be able to vote.

We understand that these locations have been temporally closed by state and local officials however they will be open for Tuesday's election. The Board of Elections has been in communications with all these locations to make sure administers and appropriate staff know they will be open for voters to cast ballots Tuesday.
