WORTHINGTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

SHALL BONDS BE ISSUED BY THE WORTHINGTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUISITION OF REAL ESTATE; CONSTRUCTING NEW SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND ADDITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS; ACQUIRING FURNITURE, FURNISHINGS AND EQUIPMENT; AND LANDSCAPING AND SITE IMPROVEMENT IN THE SUM OF FOUR MILLION DOLLARS AND A LEVY OF TAXES BE MADE OUTSIDE OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION ESTIMATED BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO AVERAGE TWO AND SEVEN-TENTHS MILLS FOR EACH ONE DOLLAR OF VALUATION, WHICH AMOUNTS TO TWENTY-SEVEN CENTS FOR EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF VALUATION, FOR A MAXIMUM PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST OF SUCH BONDS?
