

Notice of Election on Issue of Bonds

R.C. 133.18, 3501.11(G)

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Columbus, Ohio, passed on the 18th day of July, 2022, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2022 the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, and improving infrastructure for the Department of Public Service, including streets and highways and refuse collection, acquiring real estate and interests in real estate, landscaping and otherwise improving the sites thereof, and acquiring furnishings, equipment and appurtenances.

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 16 years. The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.112 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 1.12 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2023.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
