NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

OHIO REVISED CODE § 3501.03

The Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2014, at the usual places of holding elections in this County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of electing candidates to the following offices:


All Statewide Executive Offices (Governor/Lieutenant-Governor, Attorney General, Auditor of State, Secretary of State, Treasurer of State); United States Congress; Justices of the Ohio Supreme Court; Judges of the 10th District Court of Appeals; State Senate; State House of Representatives; Court of Common Pleas Judges; County Commissioner; and County Auditor.

And for the purpose of deciding the following questions and issues:

Gahanna-Jefferson City School District – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Grandview Heights City School District Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Mt.
