Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Education

Five Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$ 34,155,980)

for the purpose of

CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, FURNISHING, AND EQUIPPING A NEW SCHOOL BUILDING FOR GRADES 5-6 WITH RELATED SITE IMPROVEMENTS THERETO; CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, FURNISHING, AND EQUIPPING A NEW BUILDING WITH COMBINED ACADEMIC CLASSROOMS AND GYMNASIUM WITH RELATED SITE IMPROVEMENTS THERETO; ACQUISITION OF ATHLETIC FACILITIES UPGRADES, TECHNOLOGY AND SECURITY UPGRADES, AND FIXED AND MOVABLE EQUIPMENT FOR DISTRICT-WIDE PURPOSES AND OTHER VARIOUS DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENTS, TO ACCOMMODATE GROWTH IN STUDENT POPULATION

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 28 years.
The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.234
(Rate expressed in cents or dollars and cents)
for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 2.34 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, in excess of
the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor.

The polls for said election will be open at 6:30 o'clock a.m. and remain open until 7:30 o'clock p.m. of said day.
