

# NOTICE OF ELECTION ON ISSUE OF BONDS<sup>1</sup>

R.C. 133.18, 3501.11(G)

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council  
of the City of Columbus, Ohio,  
passed on the 14th day of July, 2008, there will be submitted to a vote  
of the people of said subdivision at the General Election to be held in the City  
of Columbus, Ohio, at the regular places of voting therein,  
on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2008, the question of issuing bonds of said  
subdivision in the principal amount of Eighty-six million one hundred seventy  
thousand Dollars (\$ 86,170,000 )

for the purpose of  
ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING AND IMPROVING FACILITIES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND  
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, INCLUDING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL ESTATE AND INTERESTS IN REAL  
ESTATE, THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RELOCATION, REMODELING, ENLARGEMENT AND  
IMPROVEMENT OF BUILDINGS AND OTHER STRUCTURES, THE ACQUISITION OF FURNISHINGS, APPARATUS,  
COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND OTHER EQUIPMENT, LANDSCAPING AND MAKING SITE IMPROVEMENTS,  
AND REFUNDING BONDS PREVIOUSLY ISSUED FOR SUCH PURPOSE

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 14 years.  
The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.056  
(Rate expressed in cents or dollars and cents)  
for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 0.56 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation,  
in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which  
the tax is expected to be due is 2009.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
