

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON BOND ISSUE AND TAX LEVY**  
R.C. 3501.11(G), 3318.06

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Education  
of the Dublin City School District, Ohio,  
passed on the 12th day of August, 2008, there will be submitted to a vote  
of the people of said subdivision at the General Election to be held in the  
(Primary, General or Special)  
school district of Dublin City Schools, Ohio, at the regular place(s) of voting therein,  
on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2008, the following questions as a single proposal:

(1) the question of issuing bonds of said Dublin City School District  
in the amount of Fifty million Dollars (\$ 50,000,000 )

for the purpose of  
expanding, renovating, and improving Davis Middle School, Karrer Middle School, and Coffman High School;  
repairing, improving, and maintaining existing school buildings and facilities; constructing, furnishing,  
and equipping a new elementary school, with related site improvements and appurtenances thereto; purchasing  
school buses and related transportation equipment; replacing and refurbishing existing equipment; and  
upgrading and improving technology and building security enhancements district-wide

as provided by law.

The maximum number of years during which such bonds are to run is 17 years.

The estimated average additional tax rate amounts to \$0.146  
(Rate expressed in cents or dollars and cents)

for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which is 1.46 mills for each one dollar of valuation, in excess  
of the ten mill limitation, as certified by the County Auditor.

(2) the question of an additional levy of taxes for the benefit of the Dublin City School District  
(Name of school district)

for the purpose of ~~paying the cost of maintaining the classroom facilities included in the project~~ <sup>current operating expenses</sup> ~~at the rate of not~~ <sup>a</sup>  
exceeding 7.9 mills ~~less than one-half mill~~ <sup>continuing period of time, commencing</sup> for each one dollar of valuation, for a ~~period of twenty-three years.~~  
in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
