

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON BOND ISSUE AND TAX LEVY**  
R.C. 3501.11(G), 3318.06

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Education  
of the South-Western City School District, Ohio,  
passed on the 14th day of July, 2008, there will be submitted to a vote  
of the people of said subdivision at the General Election to be held in the  
(Primary, General or Special)  
school district of South-Western City Schools, Ohio, at the regular place(s) of voting therein,  
on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2008, the following questions as a single proposal:

(1) the question of issuing bonds of said South-Western City School District  
in the amount of Two hundred sixty one million eight hundred six thousand  
nine hundred thirty-nine Dollars (\$ 261,806,939 )  
for the purpose of  
constructing, furnishing, and equipping new school facilities, and renovating, repairing, improving,  
furnishing, equipping, and constructing additions to existing school facilities, buildings, and  
infrastructure, with related site improvements and appurtenances thereto, under the Ohio School  
Facilities Commission Classroom Facilities Assistance Program; curriculum implementation district-wide,  
including related textbooks and technology; and acquiring land and interests in land

as provided by law.

The maximum number of years during which such bonds are to run is 28 years.

The estimated average additional tax rate amounts to \$0.633  
(Rate expressed in cents or dollars and cents)

for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which is 6.33 mills for each one dollar of valuation, in excess  
of the ten mill limitation, as certified by the County Auditor.

(2) the question of an additional levy of taxes for the benefit of the South-Western City School District  
(Name of school district)  
for the purpose of ~~paying the cost of maintaining the classroom facilities included in the project~~ <sup>current operating expenses</sup> ~~at the rate of not~~ <sup>a</sup>  
~~exceeding 6 mills~~ ~~less than one-half mill~~ <sup>continuing period of time, commencing</sup> ~~for each one dollar of valuation, for a period of twenty-three years.~~  
in 2008, first due in calendar year 2009.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
