A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 2009, at the usual places of holding elections in this County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices:

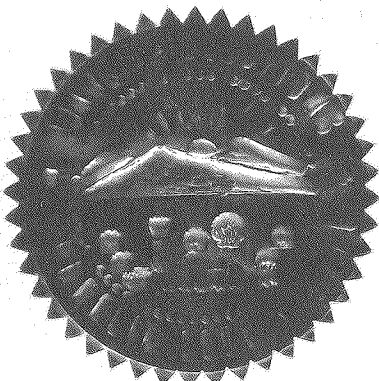
Judges of the Franklin County Municipal Court (9 Judgeships), City Offices - City Attorney (some cities), City Auditor (some cities); Members of Council; Village Offices - Member of Council, Member of Trustees of Board of Public Affairs (Village of Urbancrest); Township Trustees (2 positions), Plain Township Trustee (UTE 12/31/11), Franklin Township Fiscal Officer (UTE 3/31/12); Members of the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio, Members of Boards of Education (full terms - all districts) (UTE 12/31/11 - some districts)

And for the purpose of deciding the following questions and issues:

State Issues (3 questions); Franklin County Children Services Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement and Decrease), City of Gahanna - Proposed Charter Amendments, City of Hilliard - Proposed Charter Amendments, City of Whitehall - Recall Election, Village of New Albany - Proposed Charter Amendments, Village of Obetz - Proposed Charter, Blendon Township Police District Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal), Perry Township Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement), Pleasant Township Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement - 1.0 mill), Pleasant Township Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement - 1.57 mills), Bexley Public Library Proposed Tax Levy (Additional), Reynoldsburg City School District Proposed Tax Levy (Additional), South-Western City School District Proposed Tax Levy (Additional), Westerville City School District Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement), Worthington City School District Proposed Incremental Tax Levy; and numerous Local Option Questions.
