

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Section 3506.14 of the Ohio Revised Code requires Boards of Elections that utilize automatic tabulating equipment to test such equipment using a pre-audited group of ballots to ascertain that it will accurately count the votes cast for all questions and issues.

This test must be completed prior to the start of the ballot count and public notice must be given of the time and place of the test. The test for absentee optical scan tabulating will be conducted on Monday, July 27, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. at the Franklin County Board of Elections, 280 East Broad Street, 43215. The test for iVotronic voting system tabulating will be conducted on Monday, July 27, 2009 at 2:30 p.m. at the Franklin County Board of Elections, Logistic Division, 1719 Alum Creek Drive, 43207.
