1 Monday Afternoon Session,
2 April 6, 2015.

3 - - -

4 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Good afternoon,
5 everyone. I will call the Franklin County Board of
6 Elections meeting to order.

7 Do the roll call. Kimberly Marinello.

8 MEMBER MARINELLO: Here.

9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Gregory Haas.

10 MEMBER HAAS: Here.

11 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: And Douglas Preisse.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

13 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: We do have a quorum.

14 All those in favor -- we do have a quorum.

15 MEMBER MARINELLO: Agreed.

16 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Agreed. The first
17 item on the agenda is to go into Executive Session.

18 Is there a motion?

19 MEMBER MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I move
20 that the Board enter into Executive Session to
21 consider the appointment, employment, dismissal,
22 discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of
23 public employees and/or officials of this Board of
24 Elections.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

2 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Kimberly Marinello.

4 MEMBER MARINELLO: Yes.

5 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Gregory Haas.

6 MEMBER HAAS: Yes.

7 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: And Douglas Preisse.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes.

9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: We are now in
10 Executive Session. We would ask that everyone kind
11 of leave for a while.

12 (Executive Session was held.)

13 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move the Board of
14 Elections to come back from Executive Session where
15 no votes were taken, no decisions made.

16 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

17 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

18 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. Roll call.
19 Kim Marinello.

20 MEMBER MARINELLO: Yes.

21 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Greg Haas.

22 MEMBER HAAS: Yes.

23 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: And Douglas Preisse.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: We are now out of
2 Executive Session. The first item on the regular
3 agenda is a motion to approve the minutes of the
4 February 17 and March 2 meeting.

5 MEMBER HAAS: I move that the Board
6 approve the minutes of the February 17 and March 2
7 meetings of the Franklin County Board of Elections as
8 submitted.

9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

10 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

11 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

12 Motion carries.

13 The next item is, as you all know, Dana
14 Walch effective April 3 resigned as the Deputy
15 Director of the Franklin County Board of Elections.
16 We need a motion to accept that resignation.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I move the Board
18 accept the resignation of Dana Walch effective
19 April 3, and we thank Dana for his service to our
20 office and the citizens of Franklin County.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

22 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Okay. Any other
23 comments? And the next item --

24 MEMBER HAAS: Just from the other side I

1 would like to concur in the record that Dana was a
2 fantastic public servant and great job.

3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: I would like to put on
4 the record for the three years he worked here we got
5 along very well, and he was -- I thought he was an
6 exemplary leader as the Deputy Director of the Board,
7 and he will be sorely missed by all here in Franklin
8 County.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you both for
10 those comments. I will pass them along. I know he
11 will be especially appreciative hearing those from
12 the other side.

13 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: The next item on the
14 agenda is the hiring of a new executive director -- I
15 mean new Deputy Director.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I move that the Board
17 hire David Payne as Deputy Director of the Franklin
18 County Board of Elections beginning April 6, 2015, at
19 a compensation rate of \$58.0788 per hour.

20 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

21 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

22 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor say
23 aye.

24 Welcome aboard, Mr. Payne.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We will revert to a
 2 previous order of business, and I am going to restate
 3 the motion just to be completely clear, although we
 4 just hired a guy but we didn't vacate -- should we do
 5 the whole thing over again?

6 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Sure.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I move the Board
 8 accept the resignation of Dana Walch effective April
 9 3, and we thank Dana, as our colleagues on the other
 10 side have already as well, for his service to our
 11 office and the citizens of Franklin County.

12 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

13 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

14 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

15 Motion carries.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Just to be crystal
 17 clear I move the Board hire David Payne to replace
 18 Dana Walch as Deputy Director of the Franklin County
 19 Board of Elections beginning April 6, 2015, at a
 20 compensation rate of \$58.0788 per hour.

21 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

22 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

23 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

24 Motion carries.

1 MEMBER MARINELLO: Again welcome.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Again thank you.

3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: You need to be sworn
4 in.

5 MR. O'BRIEN: I will do that with the
6 permission of the Board right now.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do it over here, Ron,
8 so we can get a picture of the flag, Mr. Prosecutor.

9 MR. O'BRIEN: Oh, a flag.

10 (Mr. Payne was sworn in as Deputy
11 Director.)

12 MR. O'BRIEN: Congratulations.

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Now we get a proper
14 welcome.

15 MR. O'BRIEN: If you will sign this.
16 And, now, I might just say since I have the floor
17 that I have known David myself for about 20 years or
18 thereabouts, and you are getting a very good person
19 to help you get your job done, Bill.

20 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Thank you, sir. I
21 appreciate that.

22 MR. O'BRIEN: Sign right there.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you,
24 Mr. Prosecutor.

1 MR. O'BRIEN: With that I will depart the
2 meeting. Mr. Lecklider will remain to help assist if
3 there are any questions, and I will follow up on any
4 other issues.

5 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Thank you, sir.

6 MR. O'BRIEN: Thank you.

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Should I come?

8 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: You should come. You
9 are now an employee.

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay. Thank you
11 very much.

12 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All right. The next
13 item on the agenda is the paper ballot allocation.
14 Each election cycle we -- we put so many paper
15 ballots out for provisional voting and this year is
16 no different. We are recommending 25 paper ballots
17 for each ballot style for provisional voting for
18 machine backup starting with the May 5 Primary
19 Election. So we need a motion.

20 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board
21 provide 25 paper ballots for each ballot style for
22 provisional voting and machine backup at polling
23 locations for the May 5, 2015, Primary/Special
24 Election.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

2 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

3 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

4 Motion carries.

5 All right. The next item on the agenda
6 in front of you guys is Exhibit A. We also have to
7 do machine allocation. And the Exhibit A, do you
8 have one?

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: I do not.

10 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: This has every polling
11 location that's going to be open or that will have
12 voting done at the May 5 Primary and looking at the
13 number of registered active voters and the number of
14 folks voting, probably same number, and then the
15 allocation is how many machines were allocated for
16 each of those locations.

17 MEMBER MARINELLO: Are these the same
18 formulas you always do?

19 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Yes, ma'am.

20 MEMBER HAAS: I move that the Board adopt
21 the voting machine allocation formula in Exhibit A
22 compiled by the Board staff for the May 5, 2015,
23 Primary/Special Election.

24 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

2 Motion carries.

3 Also the next item on the agenda would be
4 the Pitney Bowes. They are the maker of our
5 Relia-Vote, and we had to do some needed upgrades to
6 the Relia-Vote system which is working off of the
7 Window --

8 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Windows XP.

9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Windows XP system.
10 Thank you, Carolyn. It operated off the Windows XP,
11 and we are upgrading to Windows 7, I believe, yeah.
12 And we also have to -- in order for us to be able to
13 get a good rate on mail and dealing with the post
14 office we have to include a full service IMB for the
15 system. Both of those combined -- well, the upgrade
16 is \$44,819.73, and the full service IMB is \$25,859.
17 The total cost would be \$70,678.73.

18 MEMBER HAAS: I move that the Board
19 authorize the Director and the brand new Deputy
20 Director to enter into a contract with Pitney Bowes
21 in the amount of \$70,678.73 for upgrades to the
22 operating system and the post office upgrades.

23 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

24 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

1 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

2 The next motion would be each year we do
3 a Kids Voting contract. This year that Kids Voting
4 moved to -- they now fall under the Educational
5 Service Center. And Kids Voting, as we all know,
6 they come in and they work the polls for us. They
7 are our machine judges. And the cost -- because this
8 contract is no longer under Kids Voting, it is now
9 under the Educational Service Center, and it's a new
10 year for a contract, I have a contract here that the
11 Board needs to sign off on in order for us to enter
12 into services to have Kids Voting. The total account
13 is for \$45,000, and I will pass this down. So I need
14 a motion for that.

15 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board
16 enter into a contract not to exceed \$45,000 with the
17 Educational Service Center of Central Ohio for the
18 Kids Voting Youth at the Booth program.

19 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

20 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

21 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

22 The motion carries.

23 The next item on the agenda would be to
24 enter into a personal service contract for the Voting

1 Managers for the Early Vote Center. We are looking
2 at hiring a Democrat and a Republican to run the
3 Early Vote Center starting today through I think it's
4 May 8. The last week of voting stops May 5. We will
5 keep them on until May 8 to kind of close it down.

6 MEMBER HAAS: I move the Board authorize
7 the Director and the Deputy Director to hire a
8 Democrat and Republican manager of the Early Vote
9 Center as soon as possible.

10 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second?

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

12 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor.

13 MR. LECKLIDER: Excuse me. Rate of
14 compensation.

15 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: I'm sorry, the rate of
16 compensation --

17 MEMBER HAAS: It's a personal service
18 contract.

19 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: It's a personal
20 service contract, and the rate of compensation would
21 be not to exceed \$10,400 for the little over 30 --
22 about 35 days.

23 MEMBER HAAS: Amend that and to include
24 that the personal service contract should not exceed

1 \$10,000.

2 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: \$10,000. Okay. Good
3 enough. Is there a second to that?

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

5 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: It's been properly
6 moved and seconded. All those in favor.

7 Motion carries.

8 That concludes what I have. Do any of
9 the Board Members have anything they want to bring
10 up?

11 Is there a motion to adjourn?

12 MEMBER MARINELLO: So moved. I will move
13 to adjourn.

14 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Second?

15 MEMBER HAAS: Second.

16 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor?

17 We stand adjourned.

18 (Thereupon, the meeting was concluded at
19 3:50 p.m.)


