### **Franklin County Board of Elections Revises Unofficial Voter Turnout for Nov. 6**

(Columbus)—The Franklin County Board of Elections revised the unofficial turnout for the Nov. 6, 2007 General Election this afternoon to show 176,895 voters or 22.77 percent of those registered voting at the polls or by absentee ballot. An additional estimated 4,500 individuals cast provisional ballots.

“The number of absentee voters was inadvertently included twice when calculating the total number of ballots cast” said Director Matt Damschroder. “This affected only the voter turnout calculation. Ballots were not double counted and the revision does not extend to the unofficial vote totals released by the Board on election night for individual candidates and issues.”

The Board of Elections will meet Nov. 27 to certify election results and release official vote totals including final absentee and provisional counts at that time. Certified vote totals will be posted online at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>.
