Board of Elections Open Columbus Day

(Columbus) Most Franklin County offices will be closed on Columbus Day, Oct. 13, but the Franklin County Board of Elections will remain open to continue planning for the Nov. 4 general election. The Veterans Memorial will open on the holiday for in-person absentee voting as well.

The Veterans Memorial, located at 300 West Broad Street, will maintain its weekday absentee voting schedule 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. The board of elections at 280 East Broad Street will open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for other business.

The board of elections voted earlier this year to observe President's Day, Columbus Day and Veterans Day at later dates to accommodate voters in the primary and general elections. As a result, board offices will be open on Nov. 11 to prepare for the official canvass of election results.
