Board of Elections Sets General Election In-Person Absentee Voting Hours

(Columbus) The bipartisan Franklin County Board of Elections today unanimously approved in person absentee voting hours for the Nov. 2, 2010 general election.

The schedule includes some weeknight, Saturday and holiday voting, all of which will take place at the board of elections located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus.

Eligible voters will be able to cast ballots, weekdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. from Sept. 28 to Nov. 1. Voting will be extended until 9 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 4 – the day registration closes for the election – and until 7 p.m. from Monday Oct. 25 to Friday Oct. 29.

Board offices will also open for voting from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Columbus Day, Monday, Oct. 11 and on two Saturdays, Oct. 2 and Oct. 30, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Voters also have the option of casting absentee ballots by mail. Applications for mail-in absentee ballots will be sent to more than 600,000 active Franklin County voters later this month.
