Absentee Voting Ends Monday

(Columbus) Absentee voting for the Nov. 2, 2010 general election ends Monday. The board of elections has these reminders for voters who plan to cast their absentee ballots by mail or in-person at the board:

- The board of elections is located at 280 E. Broad Street, Columbus and will be open for in-person voting from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. tomorrow, Sat. Oct 30, from 1p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 31 and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, Nov. 1.

All other voted absentee ballots must be returned to the board of elections by the following deadlines to count in the general election:

- Ballots returned in- person must arrive at the board of elections by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
- Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Nov. 1 and arrive by Nov. 12.

Voted absentee ballots will not be accepted at any polling location on Election Day.

Voters who've requested an absentee ballot, but have not used it, may vote a provisional ballot on Election Day at their usual polling place.
