Board of Elections Alerts Voters to Updated Voting Location Information

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections sent letters to 4,860 voters today alerting them of errors in voting location reminder cards they'd recently received for the general election.

One error listed the correct addresses but the former names of two school buildings recently renamed by Columbus Public Schools since they were last used for voting in the May primary election.

- **Letters explained that the voting location for Columbus precinct 27-A at 3450 Medway Avenue was previously called Eastmoor Middle School, but is now named the Columbus Preparatory School for Boys. There are 995 voters in the precinct.**
- **Voters also were notified that the voting location for Columbus precincts 55-A and 55-C at 1390 Bryden Road was called Franklin Middle School in the primary, but is now named Columbus Preparatory School for Girls. There are 841 voters in 55-A and 1,308 voters in 55-C.**

The second error transposed the addresses for Columbus precincts 26-C and 26-D. Letters to those voters provide the correct addresses for each precinct and explain that their voting location for this election is the same as it was for the primary:

- **The correct voting location for Columbus 26-C is the Corinthian Missionary Baptist Church at 3161 East Fifth Avenue. There are 890 voters in 26-C.**
- **The correct voting location for Columbus 26-D is Summit's Trace HealthCare Center at 935 North Cassady Avenue. There are 826 voters in 26-D. .**

Letters have been sent by first class mail to all voters impacted by these updates.
