Important Absentee Ballot Return Deadlines

(Columbus) Voters are reminded that they have until 7:30 p.m. today, Nov. 8, to return any voted absentee ballots in-person to the Franklin County Board of Elections, located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus.

- **Absentee ballots may only be returned in-person to the board of elections today. They may not be returned to local polling places open today.**
- **They may not be returned by mail from within the United States. That deadline expired yesterday.**
- **Out-of-country military and civilian absentee ballots must be received by Nov. 18.**

Voters who requested an absentee ballot, but did not use it, may cast a provisional ballot at their local polling place today.

Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Voters may call the board of elections at 525-3100 or visit our Web site <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> to find the address of their polling place. The Web site also lists a sample ballot for each precinct.
