Voting Location Changing for Two Precincts in Primary

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections has announced a voting location change for the May 7 primary election for voters in two precincts.

The polling place for voters in Columbus 82 G and 82 H is moving from the Church of the Resurrection at 6300 East Dublin Granville Road to the New Albany Branch of the Columbus Metropolitan Library at 200 Market Street less than a half mile away. More than 2,500 voters are registered in these precincts.

The move is for the primary election only and is necessary because church officials recently discovered they'd agreed to host another event on the day of the primary and would be unable to serve as a polling place.

The board of elections will mail notices of the address change to the voters in these precincts. A sign will also be posted at the church on Election Day to direct any stray voters to the library voting site nearby.
