Two Issues Filed for August Special Election

(Columbus) Some, but not all Franklin County voters, will have a special election August 5.

Two issues were submitted in advance of yesterday's 4:00 p.m. filing deadline for this election – a three mill levy for fire services in Jefferson Township and a levy of 2.85 mills for the Licking Heights School District.

If approved, the Jefferson Township levy would generate nearly \$1.4 million in its first year for fire protection. The Licking Heights levy would raise more than \$26 million over 37 years for school renovation and construction.

Franklin County voters in 17 precincts will be eligible for the Jefferson Township levy. Others in 10 precincts will be eligible for the school levy. Five precincts will vote on both issues.

Voters must be registered by July 7 to be eligible for this election. Approximately 8,800 are presently registered in Jefferson Township and 8,500 eligible in Franklin County's portion of the Licking Schools levy.
