Absentee Voting Begins Oct. 7 for General Election

(Columbus) Absentee voting for the Nov. 4 general election will begin Tuesday, Oct. 7 with the start of in-person voting and early voting by mail.

All registered voters have received applications in the mail from the Ohio Secretary of State to vote by mail in this election.

Voters in Franklin County will have the option of voting early in- person at the board of elections located at 1700 Morse Road at the following times:

- **Weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. except for Monday, Oct. 13 when boards of elections will be closed for Columbus Day.**
- **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Saturdays, Oct. 25 and Nov. 1**
- **1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 2**
- **8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday, Nov. 3**

Absentee ballots returned in-person must arrive at the board of elections by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day Nov. 4. **Voters may not return them to their regular Election Day polling location.**

Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Nov. 3 and arrive no later than Nov. 14 to count in this election.
