A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2016, at the usual places of holding elections in this County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of choosing the following offices:


**President and Vice President; U.S. Senator; Representative to Congress; Chief Justice of the Supreme Court; Justices of the Supreme Court; Judges of the 10<sup>th</sup> District Court of Appeals; State Senator; State Representative; Judges of the Court of Common Pleas; County Commissioner; Prosecuting Attorney; Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas; Sheriff; County Recorder; County Treasurer; County Engineer; Coroner; and Member of the State Board of Education.**

And for the purpose of deciding the following questions and issues:

**Columbus – Proposed Bond Issues; Gahanna – Proposed Charter Amendments; Upper Arlington – Police and Fire Pension Levy (renewal with decrease); Worthington – Proposed Charter Amendments; Valleyview – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal); Clinton Township – Proposed Police Levy (additional); Franklin Township – Proposed Fire Levy (additional); Franklin Township – Proposed Limited Home Rule; Hamilton Township – Proposed Fire Levy (additional); Truro Township – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Bexley City School District – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Columbus City School District – Proposed Bond Issue and Tax Levies; Hilliard City School District – Proposed Bond Issue and Tax Levy; Licking Heights Local School District – Proposed Tax Levy (additional); Westerville City School District – Proposed Tax Levy (substitute); Central Ohio Transit Authority – Proposed Sales and Use Tax (renewal); Grandview Heights Public Library – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal with increase); New Albany Plain Local Joint Park District – Proposed Tax Levy (replacement); Upper Arlington Public Library – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal); and numerous local liquor options.**
