DEPUTY DIRECTOR WALCH: Just for clarification on this, we did receive -- I received an e-mail from Mr. Katz over the weekend, and then we did receive a letter from him today, correct, Jeff, indicating Mr. Katz's desire to remove himself as a candidate for Hilliard City Council?

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And will his name appear on the ballot?

DEPUTY DIRECTOR WALCH: His name will appear on the ballot, but we will include in every absentee ballot that goes out a notice that he withdrew as a candidate and post it on the machines on election day that he withdrew and that any ballots cast for his candidacy would not be counted.
