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4 1 2 PROCEEDINGS 3 4 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Good afternoon. I 5 would like to call the Franklin County Board of Elections to order. I will do the roll call. 6 7 Kimberly Marinello. 8 MS. MARINELLO: Here. 9 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Douglas Preisse. 10 MR. PREISSE: Here. 11 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Bradley Sinnott. 12 MR. SINNOTT: Here. 13 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Mr. Chairman, we have 14 a quorum. The first item of business would be the 15 16 approval of the minutes of April 6, 2015. 17 MR. SINNOTT: I move that the minutes of 18 the meeting of the Franklin County Board of Elections held on April 6, 2015, be approved as submitted. 19 20 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second? 21 MS. MARINELLO: Second. 2.2 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor say 23 aye. 24 (Vote taken; motion passed.)

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: I will pass this around so everybody can sign. The only item on the agenda today is a challenge of the right to vote and a correction of registration. We have Renee Klco.

Will you walk us through, Renee?

MS. KLCO: We have a challenger, Linda Carey who is challenging Beth Blessing. She says

8 that the address that Ms. Blessing is using on

9 Dunedin, she does not live there. She actually lives

10 in Upper Arlington.

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Through my research I found that

Ms. Blessing actually owns the property on Dunedin.

There's another Blessing that lives at that same

address. She votes from that address.

The address in Upper Arlington is owned by a John Ledbetter, and I have no indication that she lives in Upper Arlington. I just show that she resides on Dunedin, Clintonville, so my recommendation is we leave her on the voter rolls.

MS. MARINELLO: I agree.

MR. SINNOTT: Okay.

I move that the Board deny the challenge of the --

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      no, she did not respond to the letter.
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                  MR. SINNOTT: You say it was not returned
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      to us?
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                  MS. KLCO: No, it was not.
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                  MR. SINNOTT: Ms. Carey was invited to
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      come here and tell us why she doesn't believe
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      Ms. Blessing is where she registered to vote, and we
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7 1 have heard nothing from her; is that right? 2 MS. KLCO: No, we have not. 3 MS. MARINELLO: I move that the Board 4 deny the challenge of Right to Vote and Correction of 5 Registration List filed by Linda Carey of 521 East 6 Stanton Avenue, Columbus, Ohio, against Beth 7 Blessing, purportedly of 506 Dunedin Road, Columbus, 8 Ohio, 43214, and order that Beth Blessing's 9 registration be preserved in Franklin County. 10 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Is there a second? 11 MR. SINNOTT: There is. 12 DIRECTOR ANTHONY: All those in favor say 13 aye. 14 (Vote taken; motion passed.) DIRECTOR ANTHONY: Motion carried. 15 16 Is there anything else to come before the 17 Board? 18 MR. SINNOTT: I have a question. Must we have an ad hoc Special Meeting of the Board to vote 19 20 on a voter challenge? 21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We discussed this a 2.2 little earlier before the meeting commenced.

Even if the Legislature did tell us we must decide the challenge within five days or whatever it is, there might be an opportunity to explain that to the challenger and have the challenger agree to withdraw and then refile the challenge so it would coincide with the regularly scheduled Board meeting.

MR. SINNOTT: It seems unfortunate that
the Board has nothing more to discuss than this.

MR. LECKLIDER: I will look into that.

MR. SINNOTT: Okay.

DIRECTOR ANTHONY: If that's all before

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the Board, is there a motion to adjourn?
