MEMBER SEXTON: I move that the Board approve the minutes of the April 3rd, 2017, meeting of the Franklin County Board of Elections as submitted.

MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in favor signify by saying aye.

All opposed, same sign.

(Vote taken; motion passes.)

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

The other item of business that we're required to do is opening of the polls. We have a primary election tomorrow, and the polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.

ACTING CHAIRMAN SINNOTT: Well, I think we ought to have an election tomorrow, so I move that the polls be declared open for the Tuesday, May 2, 2017, primary election beginning at 6:30 a.m., closing at 7:30 p.m., and that in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3501.32, any voter in line prior to the close of the polls at 7:30 p.m. shall be permitted to vote.

MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in

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favor signify by saying aye.
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All opposed, same sign.

(Vote taken; motion passes.)

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion carries.

Then typically what we do at this point is recess, and then we can be subject to recall by the Chair.

MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board recess this meeting of the Board of Elections, subject to recall by the Chair, until after the close of the election being held on Tuesday, May 2nd, 2017.

ACTING CHAIRMAN SINNOTT: Second.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All those in favor signify by saying aye.

All opposed, same sign.

(Vote taken; motion passes.)

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: I think, unless
there's anything else --

DIRECTOR LEONARD: I was just mentioning to Gary and to Rebecca about the open house that we're having here on the 17th, just to remind you that's available. I haven't checked with Suzanne lately to see what kind of response we're getting from some of the County Commissions and Boards of Elections, but we're availing the opportunity. I

know she said some have immediately, you know, contacted her back and said oh, yeah, we'd like to be there, who all is going to be there. So right now we've got all five certified vendors for the State of Ohio will be there, so -- and they'll be downtown at the State House the day before, if the State House works better for some of us.

ACTING CHAIRMAN SINNOTT: Thinking ahead, how many additional gatherings of the Board do we need because of the primary?

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We have -- so the first day we can start the canvass is the 13th. That's a Saturday. So we'll start the canvass on the 15th, which is Monday, and then what we would like to do probably is give us a week there and have the next meeting on Monday, May 22nd. We have to be certified by the 23rd.

MEMBER MARINELLO: I'll be out of town.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: On the 22nd?

MEMBER MARINELLO: Yes.

ACTING CHAIRMAN SINNOTT: I will see if I can get Doug here.

MEMBER MARINELLO: All right.

DIRECTOR LEONARD: Will you be available

25 that Friday before, though, so if we held -- if we
