3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: So in our
4 last meeting, we accepted the resignation of a
5 board member, Josh Jaffe, who we are sorry to lose.
6 He's working at the Secretary of State's office in
7 a good job, so we haven't really lost him, we're
8 still working with him, so we had a vacancy. And
9 it's a good thing we got an appointment from the
10 Secretary of State because our board member, Kim
11 Marinello, broke her ankle, so we absolutely need a
12 new board member.

13 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: This will be a
14 good time for the republicans to outnumber the
15 democrats and do what we need, right?

16 MEMBER SEXTON: Well, maybe today.

17 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Okay. You're
18 right, I looked outside. Never mind.

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: So prior to
20 starting our meeting, I think we'll ask Meredith
21 Freedhoff to come up here and we'll ask Judge Dan
22 Hawkins to perform the oath.

23 (Oath administered to Meredith
24 Freedhoff.)

1 JUDGE HAWKINS: Congratulations.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

3 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Thank you,
4 Your Honor. Thank you, sir.

5 MS. FREEDHOFF: Do I sign this now,
6 David?

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: I think so,
8 yes.

9 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Do we have a
10 quorum? Let's take a --

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We'll go
12 ahead and take roll.

13 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Yes.

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Kim
15 Marinello.

16 (No response.)

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton.

18 MEMBER SEXTON: Here.

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug
20 Preisse.

21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Member
23 Freedhoff.

24 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Here.

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We do have a
2 quorum, Mr. Chairman.

3 The first item on the agenda is the
4 approval of minutes from the July 5th, 2023 meeting
5 of the Franklin County Board of Education. I
6 believe Erin Gibbons sent out all the minutes to
7 the last meeting, and hopefully you had a chance to
8 look at those.

9 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
10 that the Board approve the minutes of
11 July 5th, 2023 meeting of the Franklin County Board
12 of Elections.

13 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Second.

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
15 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
16 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

17 (Vote taken.)

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
19 same sign.

20 (No response.)

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
22 carries.

23 The next item on the agenda is the
24 paper ballot allocation for tomorrow's special

1 election, and I'll call upon Carla Patton, our
2 operations manager, to give that report. I believe
3 we're required, Carla, to approve -- or the Board
4 needs to approve the allocations of both the paper
5 ballots and the machines three times; is that
6 correct?

7 MS. PATTON: Twice.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Twice. Two
9 times. So this will be second time that --

10 MS. PATTON: This will be the second
11 time required within the 30 days of the election.

12 Good afternoon. In your packet, you
13 should have Exhibit A, which is the final paper
14 ballot allocations for the August 8th, 2023 special
15 election. The formulas have not changed and the
16 allocations have not changed since the previous
17 presentation of the exhibit. The allocations do
18 meet the requirements for the provisional ballots
19 as well as in addition to that five percent of the
20 provisional ballots and like election cast. It is
21 also including the election day paper ballots,
22 which was eight percent turnout -- eight percent of
23 the turnout of the previous like elections which we
24 referenced at the special congressional of

1 August 2021 as the most similar with a higher
2 turnout than the previous August special elections.

3 So with the recommendation, no
4 precinct is getting less than 50 ballots for
5 their -- each precinct and their location. We do
6 have the ability here in the office on demand to
7 print ballots and get them out to the locations,
8 and poll workers are instructed, if they start
9 running low, to inform us so we can distribute
10 ballots to the location.

11 So with the recommended allocation,
12 we are sending out 62,155 paper ballots for this
13 election. The majority of voters will typically
14 opt to go for the machines, so we feel that this is
15 an adequate allocation for the election and we
16 would ask for your approval.

17 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: And Carla,
18 remind us again, as I think you just did, the
19 statutory minimum is 50 ballots per precinct,
20 irrespective of the size?

21 THE WITNESS: We don't really have a
22 statutory limit or statutory requirement for paper
23 ballots because we operate a hybrid-type system
24 where we have a option for paper ballots, and so

1 it's at our Board's discretion. The only statutory
2 requirement we have would be the provisional ballot
3 allocation which is incorporated in the number of
4 provision ballots of five percent of that number.

5 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Okay. All
6 right. Thank you.

7 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
8 the Board adopt the paper ballot allocation formula
9 in Exhibit A compiled by the Board's staff for the
10 August 8th, 2023 special election.

11 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Second.

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
13 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
14 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

15 (Vote taken.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
17 same sign.

18 (No response.)

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
20 carries.

21 Since you're up there, Carla, we'll
22 ask you to do the voting machine allocation for the
23 special election tomorrow.

24 MS. PATTON: In your packet will be

1 Exhibit B, which is the final voting equipment
2 recommended allocation for the August 8th, 2023
3 special election. This is the allocations of the
4 ballot marker devices which includes both the
5 tabletop and the kiosk ADA ballot markers as well
6 as the ballot scanners or the counters.

7 For the allocation of the markers,
8 those are allocated roughly for -- one marker for
9 every 375 voters. We do not have any statutory
10 requirements on those. And then the ballot
11 scanners for every 11 machines. Marking devices
12 that they have, they get one ballot counter scanner
13 for tabulations. So you'll see some locations with
14 one. Most have one ballot counter, many have two,
15 and there's some three and four special in there.
16 So the final allocation for all the locations
17 equivalent is 2,661 ballot markers are going out
18 with 489 ballot counters going out to the
19 locations. So we would ask that you approve this
20 allocation.

21 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Questions?
22 Discussion?

23 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: This is my first
24 time looking at one of these, so my question would

1 be: How does this compare to other earlier
2 elections, the numbers that you have?

3 MS. PATTON: The number of pieces of
4 equipment is larger than what we would typically
5 deploy in an August election, knowing that there
6 would probably be a little more turnout in this
7 one. I will say that it's shown in the early vote
8 center, if you've been here with the lines, we have
9 not had issues with the machines filling up at any
10 point in time, so that would not be a concern of
11 ours for this election of not having enough
12 machines; however, if there were locations that do
13 have a rush of voters that maybe was a little
14 higher than anticipated, we do have additional
15 equipment here that we can deploy at a moment's
16 notice.

17 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So any of these
18 locations could say we've got a long line. Can you
19 help us out?

20 MS. PATTON: Exactly.

21 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: That's great.

22 MS. PATTON: We can get some
23 additional equipment out to them.

24 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

1 Well, that being said, Mr. Chairman,
2 I move that the Board adopt the voting machine
3 allocation formula in Exhibit B compiled by the
4 Board staff for the August 8th, 2023 special
5 election.

6 MEMBER SEXTON: I'll second.

7 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: It's been
8 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
9 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

10 (Vote taken.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
12 same sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion
15 carries.

16 The next item on the agenda is we
17 have four withdrawals from candidates. I'm going
18 to ask Jeff Mackey, the manager of petitions and
19 filings, to walk us through those withdrawals.

20 MR. MACKEY: I'm ready to move on to
21 the general election. I don't know about the rest
22 of you, but...

23 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Are you
24 carrying a flag for any particular --

1 THE WITNESS: I was handed this flag
2 for -- in honor of our new Board member.

3 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Good. I like
4 it.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: You don't get
6 one.

7 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: I got that
8 one.

9 MR. MACKEY: You have before you
10 four candidates who were previously declared
11 nominated by the Board, after filing petitions for
12 the primary election, who have chosen to withdraw
13 from the ballot.

14 Michael Shannon has filed written
15 notice that he intends to withdrawal from the
16 Whitehall City Attorney race; Janie D. Roberts from
17 the Franklin County Municipal Court judge election;
18 Omar Tarazi, republican from the Hilliard City
19 Council election; and Carol Beckerle from the
20 Columbus City Schools Board of Education. She
21 was -- hers just came in today, so it's not
22 reflected on your minutes there.

23 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Okay. Do you
24 want them all together or should we do them one by

1 one?

2 MS. HOFER: I think it's on here one
3 by one. I think it's fine that he explained it all
4 together, but...

5 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yeah. You make a
6 motion for each one separately.

7 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Okay. I move
8 that the Board accept withdrawal of Michael
9 Shannon, candidate for the Office of Whitehall City
10 Attorney in the November 7, 2023 general election.

11 MEMBER SEXTON: I'll second.

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
13 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
14 the motion, signify by the saying "aye."

15 (Vote taken.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
17 same sign.

18 (No response.)

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
20 carries.

21 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman, I
22 move that the Board accept the withdrawal of Janie
23 D. Roberts, candidate for the Office of Municipal
24 Court judge in the November 7th, 2023 election.

1 MEMBER SEXTON: I'll second.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
3 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
4 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

5 (Vote taken.)

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
7 same sign.

8 (No response.)

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
10 carries.

11 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman, I
12 move that the Board accept the withdrawal of Omar
13 Tarazi, candidate for the Office of Hilliard City
14 Council, in the November 7th, 2023 general
15 election.

16 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
18 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
19 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

20 (Vote taken.)

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
22 same sign.

23 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: I'd like to
24 reject -- or, rather, object to the fact the

1 chairman so enthusiastically seconded all these
2 republicans withdrawing from the ballot.

3 MEMBER SEXTON: Getting ready to get
4 to the democrat next.

5 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Okay.

6 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: These people have
7 other plans, trust me.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It has been
9 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
10 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

11 (Vote taken.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
13 same sign.

14 (No response.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
16 carries.

17 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
18 the Board accept the withdrawal of Carol Beckerle,
19 candidate for the Office of Columbus School Board,
20 from the November 7th, 2023 general election.

21 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Second the
22 motion.

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
24 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of

1 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

2 (Vote taken.)

3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
4 same sign.

5 (No response.)

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
7 carries.

8 The next item on the agenda is the
9 Board of Election staff longevity paid -- or
10 longevity pay is as approved by the Franklin County
11 Commissioners. I will turn this over to our
12 director, Antone White, for explanation.

13 DIRECTOR WHITE: Good afternoon,
14 Board members. I just wanted to take a personal
15 point of privilege and welcome our new Board
16 member --

17 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

18 DIRECTOR WHITE: -- to our Franklin
19 County Board of Elections. We're grateful for your
20 appointment and we look forward to your service and
21 leadership, so welcome.

22 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

23 DIRECTOR WHITE: Before you today is
24 Exhibit C. These are tenure adjustments for

1 full-time employees. The deputy director and I are
2 asking for your approval of these tenure
3 adjustments. These adjustments are part of our
4 overall 2023 compensation increases for all of our
5 full-time Board employees.

6 As the Board may recall at the
7 beginning of this year, the Board of Commissioners
8 allocated funding for 2023 compensation increases,
9 which came in two parts. The first part was in
10 January where they allocated salary increases for
11 full-time non-bargaining unit employee, and in
12 February, the Board approved those increases. This
13 is the second part of that plan, which are tenure
14 adjustments for all full-time employees, and it's
15 based on years of service for working here in
16 Franklin County. An employee must be -- must be
17 employed and have a minimum of one year of service
18 to be eligible for that adjustment.

19 So pending any questions, I would
20 ask for your approval of Exhibit C.

21 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Looks good to
22 me.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
24 the Board approve Exhibit C and makes pay raises

1 retroactive to the first pay period in July of
2 2023.

3 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Second the
4 motion.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
6 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
7 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

8 (Vote taken.)

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
10 same sign.

11 (No response.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
13 carries.

14 DIRECTOR WHITE: Thank you.

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The final
16 item on the agenda for this meeting is the opening
17 of the polls for tomorrow's August special
18 election.

19 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Move that the
20 polls be declared open on Tuesday, August 8th, 2023
21 for the special election beginning at 6:30 a.m. and
22 closing at 7:30 p.m., and that in accordance with
23 Ohio Revised Code Section 3501.32, any voter in
24 line prior to the close of the polls at 7:30 p.m.

1 shall be permitted to vote.

2 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

3 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: It's been
4 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
5 the motion, signify by saying "aye."

6 (Vote taken.)

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
8 same sign.

9 (No response.)

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
11 carries.

12 There is nothing else on the agenda.

13 DIRECTOR WHITE: Dave, I just wanted
14 to -- before we adjourn this afternoon, I wanted to
15 update the Board on some final stats from early
16 voting. So can we began early voting in July -- we
17 began early voting on July 11th and it ended
18 yesterday at 5:00 p.m. We had a total of 46,674
19 early voters who came and visited our Franklin
20 County Early Vote Center. Just as comparison, we
21 had 48,851 voters in the November 2022 election, so
22 these numbers rival gubernatorial-level voting.

23 For mail voting, we had 29,963 mail
24 ballots that we issued. That's unusual. We

1 typically have more mail ballots, but I think
2 because it's an August election, we saw the reverse
3 of voting, more people voting early plus the mail
4 ballot. And then for election day tomorrow, we're
5 going to deploy 4,125 poll workers at 282 polling
6 locations.

7 So I just want to take a moment to
8 thank our staff, our entire staff who sacrificed a
9 lot this summer to put all this together. It takes
10 a lot of work to do what we do, and I'm very
11 grateful to everybody for coming together and
12 getting the job done, and we're looking forward to
13 the election tomorrow.

14 CHAIRPERSON PREISSE: Thank you for
15 that.

16 MEMBER SEXTON: I want to say thank
17 you, too, our all employees for all the work they
18 did in this August election.

19 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Yeah. So summer
20 of Issue 1 for everyone. Thank you for your
21 service here.

22 Mr. Chairman, I move that the Board
23 recess my first meeting of the Board of Elections
24 subject to recall by the Chair until after the

1 close of the election being held on Tuesday,
2 August 8th, 2023.

3 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
5 properly moved and seconded. And seeing no
6 objection, we are in recess.
