DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It looks like we have a quorum, but I will go ahead and take roll.

Kim Marinello.

MEMBER MARINELLO: (No audible response.)

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton.

MEMBER SEXTON: Here.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug Preisse.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Meredith Freedhoff.

MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Here.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We do indeed have a quorum, Mr. Chairman.

The first item on the agenda is the approval of minutes from the May 10th, 2023 meeting and the May 15th, 2023 meeting. I believe Erin sent everybody copies of those minutes.

MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I move that the

1 Board approve the minutes of the May 10th, 2023  
2 meeting and May 15th, 2023 meeting of the Franklin  
3 County Board of Elections as submitted.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
5 motion.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
7 properly moved and seconded.

8 All those in favor of the motion  
9 signify by saying aye.

10 (Vote taken.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
12 same sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
15 carries.

16 The next item on the agenda is the  
17 amended provisional ballot exhibit. And I will  
18 call on Sara Ziemba, the supervisor of voter  
19 services.

20 MS. ZIEMBA: Good morning.

21 After we had the Board meeting on  
22 last Wednesday for provisional ballots we have an  
23 amended exhibit for you. So when we open the  
24 ballots we actually found one -- when we opened the

1 envelopes there was one envelope that did not have  
2 a ballot, so we would add one more to rejected for  
3 no ballot in envelope. We also found one of the  
4 date of birth issues that were approved by the  
5 Board last Wednesday. When we did our second  
6 review changing the code from pending to approved  
7 in the system, that voter already had another vote  
8 on file. So we would move one of those to voter  
9 already voted. For a total of four no ballot in  
10 envelope, five voter already voted, for a grand  
11 total of recommended to reject of 1,134 and a grand  
12 total recommended to accept of 5,376 and the grand  
13 total collectively of 6,510 remaining the same.

14 So we would ask that the Board make  
15 a motion to approve the amended exhibit for  
16 provisional ballots.

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Thank you,  
18 Sara.

19 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move  
20 the Board approve the amended provisional ballot,  
21 Exhibit A.

22 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
23 motion.

24 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been

1 properly moved and seconded.

2 All those in favor of the motion  
3 signify by saying aye.

4 (Vote taken.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
6 same sign.

7 (No response.)

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
9 carries.

10 My understanding is that there is  
11 one absentee ballot for Board consideration. And  
12 I'll call on Adam Slane in the absentee department  
13 to present that.

14 MR. SLANE: Good morning, Chairman  
15 Preisse, members of the Board.

16 I have one absentee ballot that I  
17 could use your voter intent guidance on. Here is  
18 the ballot in question. Per Ohio Revised Code and  
19 the Ohio Election Official Manual, by a majority  
20 vote in public session the Board is able to decide  
21 voter intent on a ballot when the voter fails to  
22 mark the ballot consistently throughout. As you  
23 see in the ballot in front of you, the voter made  
24 no markings by the actual question of "yes" or



1 "no," but in the instructions on how to fill out  
2 the ballot in the top they did circle the word  
3 "no." I've never seen it. I don't think any other  
4 Board staff have seen that in their entire time  
5 working where the voter possibly made their intent  
6 in the instructions. So we wanted to bring that  
7 before you this morning to give us guidance.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I can recall in  
9 many instances in the past we've seen a pattern in  
10 a ballot, on a paper ballot, --

11 MR. SLANE: Yes. I --

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- that we could  
13 track. Here we've got, as was mentioned at the  
14 last Board meeting, one question, one indication,  
15 one marking.

16 MR. SLANE: Right.

17 Normally, the staff -- we have  
18 guidance because generally the ballot is  
19 significantly longer than one question and we can  
20 look at voter's markings on other contests that are  
21 clear to then give us guidance on how they mark  
22 their ballot if the scanner is unable to read and  
23 raises a question. And due to one issue only,  
24 there isn't much guidance we can go on looking at

1 the voter's other marks.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: So being as  
3 we have three board members, I believe it would  
4 take all three Board members to either accept or  
5 reject.

6 MEMBER SEXTON: Just my opinion,  
7 Mr. Chairman. I mean, I know it's clearly stated  
8 up top, but it's nowhere even close to anywhere  
9 around a half page down the actual yes-and-no part.  
10 So --

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Right.

12 MS. HUMMER: If I may provide this  
13 guidance for you. The circling of "no" at the top  
14 could have other meanings other than a vote. For  
15 instance, I don't want to vote and I'm sending this  
16 in. So because you have multiple ways to interpret  
17 that, it should lend itself to whether or not --

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Again, as I said,  
19 repeating myself, sometimes we see multi-question  
20 ballots and you can tell what someone was trying to  
21 do. This one is hard to tell what they're trying  
22 to do, in my opinion.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: I would agree.

24 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I agree.

1                   MEMBER SEXTON: So I guess we would  
2 be moving that the Board not approve.

3                   So, Mr. Chairman, I would move that  
4 the Board not approve the counting of the  
5 additional absentee ballot and that --

6                   MR. SLANE: It should be under, not  
7 counted.

8                   MEMBER SEXTON: It should be under  
9 not counted?

10                  MR. SLANE: Well, so the scanner  
11 currently reads it as an under vote, meaning the  
12 voter made no choice. So it's not that we would  
13 reject the ballot, but that we -- you just don't  
14 make intent.

15                  MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I  
16 would withdraw that.

17                  I would move that the Board not  
18 approve the counting of this additional absentee  
19 ballot and that all absentee ballots deemed valid  
20 will counted and included in the official canvass  
21 for the August 8th, 2023 special election.

22                  MS. HUMMER: I believe what they  
23 want is a motion to accept the ballot as is,  
24 meaning it will not -- it will be counted as an

1 under.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So one less under  
3 vote.

4 MEMBER SEXTON: I will move that the  
5 ballot be counted as is with one less under vote.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
7 motion.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
9 properly moved and seconded.

10 All those in favor of the motion  
11 signify by saying aye.

12 (Vote taken.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
14 same sign.

15 (No response.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
17 carries.

18 The next item would be the remaking  
19 of absentee ballots, which is not required in this  
20 instance. So we will go to election day ballot for  
21 Board review. And I will call on Carla Patton, the  
22 manager of operations.

23 MS. PATTON: Good morning.

24 Upon the scanning of the curbside

1 ballots that were cast at the polls on election  
2 day, those ballots get scanned in here back in the  
3 tabulation room on election night. And as a result  
4 of that scanning, we had a ballot that was kicked  
5 out for an indeterminate marking on the ballot.

6           Again, as was stated before, you  
7 don't have the other races to find the consistency  
8 of the markings on this ballot. They circled "no,"  
9 but there's a marking in both the "yes" and the  
10 "no" ovals. So we need to know whether this is a  
11 yes, a no, or an over vote.

12           MEMBER SEXTON: On this one  
13 obviously they marked them both. So I think it  
14 would be hard to determine whether that's a yes or  
15 no. One was checked and one was circled. So on  
16 this one, it would be appropriate to just not count  
17 it, not count it as under vote.

18           MS. PATTON: Well, it would have  
19 been a ballot cast. It would be counted as an over  
20 vote if you are unable to determine one way or the  
21 other since they have markings in both ovals. It  
22 would be counted as an over vote ultimately.

23           MEMBER SEXTON: So the motion would  
24 be to accept it but not count it as -- or count it

1 as an over vote?

2 MS. PATTON: Correct.

3 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I  
4 would move that the Board accept the counting of  
5 this additional provisional ballot as an over vote  
6 and that all provisional ballots deemed valid and  
7 counted be included in the official canvass for the  
8 August 8th, 2023 election.

9 MS. HUMMER: And reject this.  
10 Right?

11 MS. PATTON: Correct that to an  
12 election day ballot non-provisional.

13 MEMBER SEXTON: I would amend the  
14 motion to count it as an election day  
15 non-provisional ballot.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
17 motion.

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
19 properly moved and seconded.

20 All those in favor of the motion  
21 signify by saying aye.

22 (Vote taken.)

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
24 same sign.

1 (No response.)

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
3 carries.

4 And Carla, will we need  
5 authorization, then, to scan that ballot? I guess  
6 we would. Right?

7 MS. PATTON: They voted to include  
8 it as an over vote.

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: But we have  
10 to scan it or do we not have to scan it?

11 MS. PATTON: Yeah, it would have to  
12 be scanned.

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: So we would  
14 need a motion in order --

15 MS. PATTON: We have three  
16 additional ballots that were not included on  
17 election night that are deemed valid and are to be  
18 included in the official count as well.

19 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay. May I  
20 ask something, then? So the motion would include  
21 the three plus the one for four ballots?

22 MS. PATTON: Yes. Correct.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move  
24 the Board approve the counting of four election day

1 ballots and that all election day ballots deemed  
2 valid will be counted and included in the official  
3 canvass results for the August 8th, 2023 special  
4 election.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
7 properly moved and seconded.

8 All those in favor of the motion  
9 signify by saying aye.

10 (Vote taken.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
12 same sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
15 carries.

16 The next item on the agenda is the  
17 selection of voting locations for our audit. The  
18 Secretary of State requires that in this statewide  
19 election that each board of elections perform an  
20 audit. So I will call on Jeff Mackey, the manager  
21 of --

22 DIRECTOR WHITE: We'll have to table  
23 this. We have to certify an election before we can  
24 do the precincts for the audit.



1 MS. HUMMER: I think they're saying  
2 that once the scanning occurs, then you can  
3 certify.

4 DIRECTOR WHITE: Correct. We're not  
5 certifying right now.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Can we proceed  
7 with an audit if we don't certify?

8 DIRECTOR WHITE: No. They're going  
9 to go run the ballots and then draw the report for  
10 you all to certify the election; but in the  
11 meantime, we can move on to other Board business.  
12 The audit has to be done after the certifying.

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So let's pass on  
14 that.

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay. Well,  
16 let's get to the voter registration challenges,  
17 then.

18 There was a challenge made by -- I  
19 believe there are two challenges made by Timothy  
20 Davey. Is Timothy --

21 Mr. Chairman, do we need to swear  
22 in --

23 MS. HUMMER: Everybody testifying  
24 today should be sworn in.

1                   CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Let's  
2 have --

3                   DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We're going  
4 to have an explanation from staff first and then  
5 we'll call on Mr. Davey.

6                   This is Travis Simmons.

7                   MS. HUMMER: I would place him under  
8 oath as well.

9                   DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: He is the --  
10 Travis is the manager of voter services.

11                   (Travis Simmons was sworn by the  
12 reporter.)

13                   MR. SIMMONS: I'm going to present a  
14 challenge by Tim Davey. Mr. Davey has challenged  
15 the voter registration status of Andrew Habing and  
16 of Jamie Marie Habing.

17                   And Mr. Davey has been registered to  
18 vote in Franklin County since 1989. Over the  
19 course of his time as a registered voter in  
20 Franklin County, Mr. Davey has regularly voted at  
21 the polls in person and in nearly every election  
22 for which he was eligible to vote. Mr. Davey  
23 updated his voter registration to his current  
24 address of 151 South Keethler Drive in Westerville,

1 Ohio, on November the 14th, 2003, and he's remained  
2 registered at that address since that date.

3 Mr. Davey affirmed on his voter  
4 challenge form that the challenged voters, Andrew  
5 Habing and Jamie Marie Habing, sold their home in  
6 Franklin County and have purchased a home in  
7 Florida. He supplied copies of the deeds of sale  
8 and the purchase which have been provided to the  
9 Board. You can see in the exhibit the voter  
10 registration forms for Mr. Davey.

11 We'll start with Andrew, the first  
12 person --

13 MEMBER SEXTON: Yeah. I'm trying to  
14 find the pertinent materials.

15 MR. SIMMONS: Just to reiterate,  
16 Mr. Davey is a registered voter here in Franklin  
17 County since 1989 and he's regularly voted. And he  
18 supplied to the staff information that the Habings  
19 have sold their home in Franklin County and they  
20 purchased a new home in Florida. He supplied  
21 copies of the deeds of sale and purchase for  
22 this -- purchase of a house in Florida.

23 You'll see also the voter history  
24 for Andrew Habing, and you'll see on the next page

1 his provisional ballot affirmation form from the  
2 2016 presidential election. In the next exhibit  
3 you'll see the voting history for Jamie Habing and  
4 also her provisional ballot affirmation form from  
5 the 2016 November general election.

6 Mr. Habing registered to vote in  
7 Franklin County at 1241 Wallean Drive in  
8 Westerville with his 2016 general election  
9 provisional affirmation statement. Mr. Habing  
10 voted one other time in Franklin County and that  
11 was in the November general election of 2020 at the  
12 polls on election day. That was his last voter  
13 activity here in Franklin County.

14 Ms. Habing registered to vote at  
15 1241 Wallean Drive in Westerville, Ohio, also with  
16 her 2016 general election provisional affirmation  
17 statement.

18 In December of 2022, as part of the  
19 2022 general voter records maintenance program  
20 which was ordered by the Secretary of State in  
21 Directive 2022-46, Mr. and Mrs. Habing's voter --  
22 voting records were changed from active to inactive  
23 status because the U.S. Postal Service indicated  
24 that they had informed them that their residential

1 address was now 16081 Pennyroyal Lane in Punta  
2 Gorda, Florida.

3 In January of 2023 our office sent  
4 the SOS Form 10-S confirmation notices to the  
5 Habings at their Florida address and asked them to  
6 confirm or cancel their Ohio voter registration.  
7 As of this date, our office has not received a  
8 response to those notices. At the current time  
9 Mr. and Mrs. Habing's voter registration will be  
10 kept for inactivity following the next federal  
11 election as part of the maintenance process if  
12 there is no additional voter activity between now  
13 and then.

14 Mr. Davey supplied an additional  
15 document, as stated earlier. Mr. Davey supplied  
16 additional documentation of the deed of sale of the  
17 home in Ohio and the deed of purchase of the home  
18 in Punta Gorda, Florida, for Mr. and Mrs. Habing  
19 with his challenge.

20 The NCOA, the National Change of  
21 Address, for those who don't know, data our office  
22 received in December of 2022 supports the challenge  
23 of Mr. and Mrs. Habing's voter registration status  
24 that they do not live in Ohio at this time and we

1 recommend that the Board approve the challenge of  
2 Mr. Davey against Mr. and Mrs. Habing.

3 MS. HUMMER: Can you please provide  
4 to the Board the notice that was given for this  
5 hearing?

6 MR. SIMMONS: Okay.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: You're suggesting  
8 we should hear it or add to the record?

9 MS. HUMMER: You should add it to  
10 the record based on under-oath testimony from Erin.

11 (Erin Gibbons was sworn by  
12 reporter.)

13 MS. HUMMER: Go ahead and provide to  
14 the Board all the steps taken in this voter  
15 challenge.

16 MS. GIBBONS: We sent Mr. and  
17 Mrs. Habing subpoenas for this meeting more than a  
18 week ago. We contacted both of them by telephone  
19 and left messages. We did not hear back. And we  
20 put a daily reporter notice in as well.

21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay.

22 MS. HUMMER: The subpoenas, were  
23 those sent to the Florida address?

24 MS. GIBBONS: No, they were not.

1 They were sent to their address at which they are  
2 registered to vote here in Ohio.

3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay.

4 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: An Ohio telephone  
5 number as well?

6 MS. GIBBONS: Yeah.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: All right.

8 Questions?

9 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, just  
10 have a question.

11 The way this is written, it is a  
12 challenge to Andrew Habing.

13 MR. SIMMONS: Andrew and Jamie, yes,  
14 sir.

15 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: And you have a  
16 copy of the deed of the Florida house?

17 MR. SIMMONS: Yes, ma'am.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I know Mr. Davey  
19 is here and started to approach the podium. I  
20 don't know that we need to hear any more, but if  
21 you'd like to we'd be delighted to hear what you --

22 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I'd like to hear.

23 (Mr. Davey sworn by reporter.)

24 MR. DAVEY: So the reason that I

1 decided to challenge these voters, I happen to know  
2 that they moved. They're neighbors of mine and  
3 they moved a few years ago, I believe June of 2021.

4           And it just takes so long for  
5 someone to get off the voter rolls; essentially, it  
6 could be up to six years. Because they have to go  
7 two years without voting and then it's the next  
8 major election, so it can take up to six years to  
9 get someone off the voter rolls.

10           And so I'm just trying to speed that  
11 up in our area in order to prevent possible fraud,  
12 and that's the whole reason why I'm here today.  
13 And if this process works, then I hope to challenge  
14 many more to get them off the rolls sooner.

15           I do have ideas on how we could make  
16 it a more efficient process as far as cleaning  
17 everyone that doesn't live here any longer, and one  
18 would be matching the parcel ID to the physical  
19 address. Because actually, I found another voter,  
20 Ed Freedale (phonetic), and I didn't have to go  
21 through the official process for that. But they  
22 removed that voter from the rolls because that  
23 address didn't even exist.

24           And there's something I'm still



1 working on, determining exactly how they were able  
2 to certify the election because in 2016 this  
3 particular person, not these individuals, this  
4 particular person, had registered in 2012.  
5 According to the Board records, it showed that they  
6 voted in 2016. I asked to get the original  
7 registration for that voter just to see if it was a  
8 typo for the address because that address does not  
9 exist, and it was clearly the address that was on  
10 the Board records. And so then I saw that, you  
11 know, the address on the voter registration was  
12 clearly that address and that address does not  
13 exist. And so they did an investigation and they  
14 ended up removing it through another process, I  
15 guess.

16 But there's probably many more  
17 voters out there that are registered at addresses  
18 that don't exist. Because it's my understanding  
19 that the county auditor gives a range of addresses  
20 for a particular street, and as long as the address  
21 falls within that range even if it doesn't exist  
22 they think it's a valid address.

23 And so what I did is I took the  
24 parcel -- the county auditor's data and matched it

1 with the voter data and matched up the addresses.  
2 And then addresses that didn't match up, didn't  
3 have a valid address according to the property  
4 records, I looked at. And this was in my  
5 neighborhood, essentially. And --

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do you have  
7 anything else to add to this specific matter before  
8 us?

9 MR. DAVEY: No. No.

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Questions from  
11 the Board?

12 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Have you talked  
13 to your neighbors since they move?

14 MR. DAVEY: No, I have not.

15 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you.

17 MEMBER SEXTON: Thank you.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do we need to do  
19 these in two separate motions?

20 MS. HUMMER: Yes.

21 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I move that the  
22 Board approve the challenge of right to vote filed  
23 by Timothy Davey of 151 Keethler Drive,  
24 Westerville, Ohio against Andrew Habing of

1 1241 Wallean Drive, Westerville, Ohio and order  
2 that Andrew Habing's registration be removed from  
3 the Franklin County voter file.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
5 motion.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
7 properly moved and seconded.

8 All those in favor of the motion  
9 signify by saying aye.

10 (Vote taken.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
12 same sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
15 carries.

16 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move  
17 that the on board approve the challenge of the  
18 right to vote filed by -- I'm on the wrong one,  
19 Mr. Chairman.

20 I move that the Board approve the  
21 challenge of right to vote filed by Timothy Davey  
22 of 151 Keethler Drive, Westerville, Ohio against  
23 Jamie Marie Habing of 1241 Wallean Drive,  
24 Westerville, Ohio and order that Jamie Marie

1 Habing's registration be removed from the Franklin  
2 County voter file.

3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
5 properly moved and seconded.

6 All those in favor of the motion  
7 signify by saying aye.

8 (Vote taken.)

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
10 same sign.

11 (No response.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
13 carries.

14 There's one additional voter  
15 challenge filed by an Eric Cordray and a Stewart  
16 Flaherty against Delena Ciamacco.

17 Sara will pick that up.

18 (Sara Ziemba sworn by reporter.)

19 MS. ZIEMBA: All right. We have two  
20 voters who have challenged the same person. We  
21 have a challenge from Stewart Flaherty of  
22 4433 Smothers Road in Westerville, and Eric Cordray  
23 of 3734 Caracas Drive in Westerville. Both are  
24 challenging Delena Ciamacco of 4531 East Walnut

1 Street in Westerville.

2 And if you look for the page that's  
3 got R. Eric Cordray, it's got extensive  
4 documentation on this one. That will be the start  
5 of this packet. There's just a little bit of  
6 background about the two challengers and there's  
7 extensive background about the woman who's being  
8 challenged, Ms. Ciamacco.

9 Both Mr. Flaherty and Mr. Cordray  
10 state that the voter, Ms. Ciamacco, does not live  
11 at the address where she stated on her petition.  
12 So, again, I should say as a matter of background,  
13 Ms. Ciamacco has filed a petition to serve on the  
14 board of I think Blendon Township. And so the two  
15 gentleman are asserting this is a residential  
16 address where she is currently registered to vote,  
17 and they are challenging both her registration and  
18 I think then by proxy her status to run for that  
19 position in Blendon Township.

20 Just as a means of background on  
21 Mr. Cordray and Mr. Flaherty, both have been  
22 registered to vote for many decades in Franklin  
23 County. They are both very regular voters, voting  
24 absentee and at the polls. You can see their voter

1 histories in your documentation and both of them  
2 have voted from their current residential addresses  
3 for many years, and as recently as this August 2023  
4 with the special. I won't spend too much time on  
5 that.

6 And if you flip through to find the  
7 page that says Delena Ciamacco at the top, this  
8 will be the bulk of the information here that you  
9 will need to consider today.

10 Everybody find that? Okay.

11 So first you'll see Ms. Ciamacco's  
12 voter history. And she has been registered --  
13 she's currently registered to vote at 4531 East  
14 Walnut Street, and she actually has been registered  
15 there since she registered to vote in Franklin  
16 County back in November of 2004. So she has never  
17 filed a change of address form with the Franklin  
18 County Board of Elections. She has remained  
19 registered there for the entirety of her time as a  
20 registered voter in Franklin County.

21 She regularly votes absentee by  
22 mail. And you can see in all the documentation all  
23 of her absentee requests and return ID envelopes.  
24 Every time she's requested an absentee ballot, she

1 has requested that it be sent to her address at  
2 4531 East Walnut Street. So every time she asks  
3 for a ballot to be mailed, it's mailed there. She  
4 receives that ballot, sends it back to us, and on  
5 the return ID envelope also lists 4531 East Walnut  
6 Street as her current Ohio residence.

7 Like I said, she has never requested  
8 an absentee ballot be mailed to any other address  
9 but 4531 East Walnut Street over the course of  
10 nearly 20 years of voting by absentee in Franklin  
11 County.

12 As part of our internal process,  
13 once we receive a challenge form or word from a  
14 voter that perhaps some address is misclassified in  
15 our voter registration database, our team will do  
16 some searches and do some research to make sure if  
17 there is a non-residential address or business  
18 address that we reformat our database so that  
19 people can no longer be registered there.

20 You'll see -- The very last document  
21 that you have as part of our research is the workup  
22 from the Franklin County Auditor's website and it  
23 lists 4531 Walnut Street as a one-family dwelling  
24 classified as a residential building. So -- so

1 there you'll see the Franklin County Auditor has it  
2 listed as a one-family log-style dwelling and it's  
3 classified as residential there.

4 So for our research on our end, it  
5 appears that the house is residential by going off  
6 what the Franklin County Auditor says.

7 Additionally, there is one other  
8 voter registered at Ms. Ciamacco's address at  
9 4531 East Walnut Street. It's Italia A. Ciamacco  
10 who's been registered at that address since June of  
11 this year. So those are the two registered voters  
12 there.

13 And over the course of our research  
14 on this, the fact that the ballots have always been  
15 requested there and returned from there, the  
16 Franklin County Auditor establishes this residence  
17 as a one-family dwelling residential zoned, it's  
18 our recommendation that -- or in addition, there's  
19 been no instance where the U.S. Postal Service has  
20 not been able to deliver a ballot as addressed.  
21 We've never received any returned mail from  
22 4531 East Walnut Street that has been addressed to  
23 Ms. Ciamacco. And so by all accounts, from what we  
24 can see, it seems this is her valid residence and



1 she's been living there since November of 2004.

2 So that's all the research that we  
3 have to help inform your decision today. And I  
4 think we have -- all parties I think are here to  
5 talk and it's probably good to hear from all of  
6 them.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here on the Board  
8 record it appears that there was voting at the poll  
9 from the residence in question in 2004 and 2006,  
10 and thereafter, absentee; but I also see they voted  
11 at the poll in 2018. So as recent as 2018 there  
12 was a vote at the poll.

13 MS. ZIEMBA: Yeah, but predominantly  
14 absentee.

15 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: But predominantly  
16 absentee.

17 MEMBER SEXTON: So is it  
18 predominantly absentee or is it all absentee?

19 MS. ZIEMBA: Predominantly. There  
20 are three votes at polls. November of 2004,  
21 November of 2006, and August of 2018 were all at  
22 the polls, but every other vote has been absentee  
23 by mail.

24 MEMBER SEXTON: So three votes at

1 the polls since being registered in 2004?

2 MS. ZIEMBA: That's correct.

3 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: And an additional  
4 person registered to vote there in 2021?

5 MS. ZIEMBA: 2023. June of this  
6 year.

7 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: And did they vote  
8 in June of this year?

9 MS. ZIEMBA: You know what? I did  
10 not look that up. I did not look if they voted in  
11 August of this year. I'm sorry.

12 MS. FREEDHOFF: That's okay.

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Now, we have  
14 parties here that wish to address the matter. So  
15 we have the challengers first.

16 MS. HUMMER: Yes.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Unless  
18 there's any questions from the --

19 Who wants to go first?

20 THE REPORTER: I will go ahead and  
21 swear you in. If you want to state your name for  
22 me.

23 MR. FLAHERTY: Stewart Flaherty.

24 (Mr. Flaherty sworn by reporter.)

1 MR. FLAHERTY: Good morning.

2 There are several of us here from  
3 Blendon Township. And we view this as actually  
4 kind of a serious thing, not just a flighty thing.

5 Ms. Ciamacco -- Start over here.

6 Sorry. Ms. Ciamacco ran for township trustee in  
7 2017. She's running again in 2023. In both cases  
8 on her statement of candidacy she listed her  
9 address on Walnut Street as her voter residence  
10 address. The current one, she also circulated the  
11 petition and at the bottom it said, "I reside at."

12 The address you have is her business  
13 address. And I have packets here if you'd like  
14 them now or later.

15 MS. HUMMER: They'll need to be  
16 marked as an exhibit and submitted for the Board's  
17 consideration.

18 (Reporter marked Challenger  
19 Exhibit 1.)

20 MR. FLAHERTY: It is understandable  
21 that your records would show the Walnut Street  
22 address since she's been very consistent with that  
23 address. A business is operated out of there. And  
24 in your packets some of the things you have are the

1 internet listings of her real estate and her farm  
2 business at that address.

3 This occurred in 2017, and at that  
4 point in time a challenge was set to be filed with  
5 this Board of Elections that this was not a proper  
6 listing of her residence address. Unfortunately,  
7 we were not familiar with the law and it was too  
8 late to file the process or too late to file a  
9 challenge.

10 At that time the Board of Trustees,  
11 Blendon Board of Trustees, Jan Heichel, myself, Jim  
12 Welch, our fiscal officer Wade Estep, and our  
13 administrator Bryan Rhoads, all knew that a  
14 challenge was going to be filed, all were aware of  
15 the facts that it was too late to file it.

16 This is significant in two things.  
17 One is, Mr. Estep lived around the corner from  
18 where Ms. Ciamacco lives, resides, and said I'll  
19 swear I see her go home at night. The second thing  
20 in this whole issue was it's just -- it's  
21 frustrating to us because we have neighbors that we  
22 did not bring in here to say, No, no, no, she lives  
23 on Sandimark.

24 Now, if you look in the packet from

1 the auditor's office, there is the parcel that's  
2 listed at 7088 Sandimark. It is owned by  
3 Ms. Ciamacco. What we consider significant is she  
4 has applied for and received the owner occupancy  
5 tax reduction on that property for years. You only  
6 get one of those. And when you apply to the  
7 Secretary of State, the Secretary of State on the  
8 form says you must own and occupy your home as your  
9 principal place of residence January 1st the year  
10 you filed for this reduction. A person only has  
11 one principal place of residence. That principal  
12 place of residence determines, among other things,  
13 where you vote.

14 Part of our argument is that if she  
15 applies for that owner occupied status on her  
16 property, where she goes home every night, --

17 Which, by the way, we learned from  
18 the attorneys back in '17 that the Ohio Revised  
19 Code is very specific as to what they consider your  
20 domicile or your residence.

21 -- if you apply for owner occupied,  
22 that would seem to us -- the layman to say this is  
23 a statement that I live at that address. The other  
24 address is a commercial address. It is not listed

1 as owner occupied. It's listed as a farm or it  
2 gets farm taxation. And again, we have listed and  
3 I've supplied all the forms on the internet that  
4 list her real estate office, all things at that  
5 address.

6           The second part about the knowledge  
7 that the trustees had is Ms. Heichel was on the  
8 Board of Trustees, Ms. Heichel knew. And I am  
9 under oath and I swear. We had discussions with  
10 the Board about this irregularity. We were  
11 concerned then. The fact that it's a repeat  
12 offense, we're more concerned now. It says, as you  
13 know, on those forms, I file under penalty of  
14 perjury.

15           Our whole argument is that simply  
16 Ms. Ciamacco does not live -- as defined by the  
17 Ohio Revised Code she does not live at Walnut  
18 Street, she does not go home there every night.  
19 She has another property owner occupied taking the  
20 tax credit, and that's where she resides. And if  
21 we want to push it further -- I mean, we didn't  
22 bring the neighbors in, but they are there, that  
23 will certify that's where she lives.

24           Again, it would show -- and it

1 wouldn't show to you folks or anybody checking the  
2 records because of the consistency of I applied, I  
3 had an address, I always voted at that address.  
4 The fact is it's the same precinct. So it's not  
5 like she voted on something that would be somewhere  
6 else.

7           To us, the citizens, this is not a  
8 no harm, no foul, no harm done type of thing. It  
9 is a blatant deception on the petitions that are  
10 filed in the circulator's statement. And with all  
11 the things you folks hear about elections and fraud  
12 and people trying to vote or not vote, we feel this  
13 is serious.

14           We feel that anyone going to serve  
15 for public office -- and I'll point out, I served  
16 for 30-some years in public office -- anyone saying  
17 I want to serve for public office should be held to  
18 the letter of the law, should be not above the law  
19 but should follow the law. It's our contention  
20 that this has not happened.

21           With that, I'll let Eric Cordray  
22 have a quick say.

23           CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Any questions?

24           MS. HUMMER: I have one question.

1           Sir, are you aware that you can have  
2 a home office as well as have a residence?

3           MR. FLAHERTY: Yes, ma'am. And I'm  
4 also aware that the Secretary of State informed us  
5 that you may have more than one residence but not a  
6 principal residence. And we go back to the Ohio  
7 Revised Code, which defines your primary as where  
8 you go home at night and when you leave it you  
9 intend to return to it. And that's exactly the  
10 statement she certifies, especially in the  
11 circulating petition, I reside at.

12           MS. HUMMER: Right.

13           But you are aware of the ability to  
14 have a business at your home?

15           MR. FLAHERTY: Oh, yes, ma'am, very  
16 aware of that. Also aware that I don't think I can  
17 sign up and vote at my office rather than my home  
18 when they're separate.

19           MS. FREEDHOFF: And on her petition  
20 she's certifying that this is her residence, her  
21 primary residence.

22           MR. FLAHERTY: Yes.

23           MS. HUMMER: Because the statute  
24 referenced residence, not primary.



1 MR. FLAHERTY: Primary on the  
2 Secretary of State's form when you're claiming the  
3 owner occupied credit. So it's just residence.

4 MS. HUMMER: It's under 3503.02.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Voting residence.  
6 This is the most recent petition.

7 Right?

8 MR. FLAHERTY: Yes.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: 2023.

10 MEMBER SEXTON: I have a question  
11 for Jean.

12 So can you repeat that kind of?  
13 What's the difference between the actual law and  
14 what Mr. Flaherty is stating is the difference in  
15 the residence and the primary residence versus the  
16 residence, which it seems like it was a qualifier  
17 to --

18 MS. HUMMER: So under 3503.02 it's  
19 the section that is used under the law for a  
20 determination of residence. The word primary is  
21 not included in that section, but rather it's a  
22 determination of whether or not based on these  
23 facts that the residence listed on the registration  
24 meets the criteria set forth in 3503.02. And as

1 the gentleman mentioned, the idea of residence is  
2 that it's where you reside, intend to return. That  
3 is one for instance criteria set forth in that  
4 statute.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So if I had an  
6 office in a home but I did not reside there, that  
7 could not be my address for such a decision?

8 MS. HUMMER: If you have a home  
9 office but it's your home and your office, it can  
10 be your residence.

11 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Right.

12 But just because it's in a home, if  
13 I don't reside there it doesn't qualify?

14 MS. HUMMER: It depends on whether  
15 or not you meet the criteria of whether or not it's  
16 a residence determination, and that's a question of  
17 fact. If the voter indicates I reside there and I  
18 also have my office there, that is permissible.

19 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: And what are the  
20 qualifications of residence?

21 MS. HUMMER: There's a number of  
22 them, and I can -- we can print out the statute if  
23 that would help.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yeah. Let's look

1 at it.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Because now our  
3 definition of residence is that you don't go there  
4 at night, and it sounds like they don't meet that  
5 qualification.

6 MS. HUMMER: It doesn't say anything  
7 about night. It's just intention of returning.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: If it's still in  
9 the code, -- and I haven't looked at it in a few  
10 years -- it used to be -- and this applies often to  
11 people in the military or in federal service in  
12 D.C. or elsewhere traveling -- if they intended to  
13 return to that residence, that address, they can  
14 continue to vote.

15 MS. HUMMER: That's correct.

16 And if you recall, a number of years  
17 ago there was a question about our lieutenant  
18 governor who had a residence in I believe another  
19 county and it was held that he could have that  
20 residence there and his residence in I believe it  
21 was Upper Arlington and he could still be qualified  
22 because his intention was to return.

23 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Intention to  
24 return to live or intention to work?

1 MS. HUMMER: Intention to return.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

3 MR. FLAHERTY: Just from a layman's  
4 viewpoint, if I may. When you get in your car in  
5 the morning and you leave from a property and you  
6 return to that property at night, then we view that  
7 as your home. And we can bring in a ton of  
8 witnesses that say that's Sandimark, not Walnut  
9 Street.

10 So we look at it from just that  
11 simple point of view there. Plus, claiming  
12 Sandimark as owner occupied. If you're claiming  
13 the Secretary of State is saying I occupy this,  
14 gosh, again, just as a layman, that just says  
15 that's my primary residence, that's my residence.

16 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Do you know of  
17 anyone else living at Sandimark? Is there another  
18 owner occupied claim on that?

19 MR. FLAHERTY: No, not that I know  
20 of. I don't know. I just -- But in the packet it  
21 shows you from the Secretary of State or the  
22 Auditor how they list that and how they list Walnut  
23 Street.

24 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Right.

1 Thank you.

2 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Who else  
3 do we have?

4 THE REPORTER: Would you give me  
5 your name, please.

6 MR. CORDRAY: William R. Eric  
7 Cordray.

8 (Mr. Cordray sworn by reporter.)

9 MR. CORDRAY: I won't repeat what  
10 Stewart said. You've heard it once. You don't  
11 need to hear it again.

12 Further, I have been a resident of  
13 Blendon Township for three generations. My parents  
14 originally bought on Acapulco Place. My  
15 grandmother bought on Caracas. My great aunt  
16 bought on Mexico, and my sister and her husband  
17 bought on Rossville. We have been in Blendon  
18 Township for over 50 years. My parents are  
19 actually in the mausoleum at Blendon Central  
20 Cemetery. So I'm a resident of Blendon Township,  
21 plan to be for the rest of my life.

22 And I want -- I really am stressing  
23 that I like honesty and -- you know, honesty in  
24 this election. Like Mr. Flaherty said, back in

1 2017 there was an issue. I care about my township.  
2 I care about my neighbors. And according to the  
3 Secretary of State, I look at this as election  
4 fraud. I deserve to have an election investigated  
5 if need be. I deserve elections to be honest and  
6 secure. I deserve honest elections along with my  
7 neighbors in Blendon Township. Thank you.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Any questions?  
9 Thank you.

10 MS. HUMMER: And the Board should  
11 also be aware that you are permitted by law to go  
12 into executive session for deliberations about  
13 this.

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We are? Okay. I  
15 need a few minutes just to read the code here.  
16 That's what I'm trying to do, folks.

17 MS. HUMMER: We have another  
18 witness.

19 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We do?

20 MS. HUMMER: Yes. Ms. Ciamacco.

21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Yeah.  
22 Let's hear from Delena. Let's have her sworn in,  
23 please.

24 (Ms. Ciamacco sworn by reporter.)

1 MS. CIAMACCO: I've got for you a  
2 packet.

3 The reason we're here is because I'm  
4 running against their very dear friend, and I was  
5 expecting something like this. What I didn't  
6 realize is that this was going on in 2017. I wish  
7 they would have let me know then.

8 But I do have a packet of  
9 information for you. I was given one day to put  
10 this together and couldn't reach my attorney on  
11 Friday, but there is a letter from him.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yeah. Let's have  
13 it marked, then, as --

14 (Reporter marked Voter Challenge  
15 Exhibit 2.)

16 MS. CIAMACCO: That's just the most  
17 current bills that I could locate, because most of  
18 my bills are in storage for the past 20-plus years.

19 My place of business is actually in  
20 Gahanna. My home office is 4531 East Walnut  
21 Street, and that's how ReMax recognizes it as well.  
22 You'll notice I included some utility bills for the  
23 property on Sandimark, which I also own. I own  
24 four homes in Blendon Township. I don't reside in

1 those. But the bills for Sandimark also come to  
2 4531 East Walnut Street.

3 Mr. Flaherty made the comment that I  
4 go home every night to sleep. The property at  
5 4531 East Walnut Street has living quarters in it.  
6 And Mr. Morganstern, who resides in Richland  
7 County, can attest -- I've known him for over  
8 20 years -- he stays there when he's in town. It's  
9 where I have every bill.

10 So when I called in on Thursday  
11 after I received this, I thought, how do I provide  
12 proof, everything I own goes to 4531 East Walnut  
13 Street. I'm there 14 to 16 hours every day, eat  
14 three meals a day there, reside there in the  
15 evenings on occasion. He doesn't know where I  
16 sleep. My neighbors never see me because I'm never  
17 there. So and my mother, I had --

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Your neighbors  
19 never see you because you're never where?

20 MS. CIAMACCO: The neighbors on  
21 Sandimark don't see me because I'm never there, the  
22 other residence. But I do have two residences.  
23 I'm primarily at 4531 East Walnut Street.

24 I've got 20 years of documentation,



1 over 20 years that I can provide. I just have to  
2 get it out of storage. Again, I was given one day.

3 All my vehicles are registered to  
4 4531. I voted from there when I moved out of  
5 Delaware County into Franklin County. It's --  
6 Everything, my whole life, is 4531 East Walnut  
7 Street.

8 MS. HUMMER: I have a question, if  
9 permissible.

10 You indicated --

11 I actually have more than one.

12 You indicated that you have a home  
13 office at the Walnut Street address?

14 MS. CIAMACCO: That is correct.

15 MS. HUMMER: And is it safe to say  
16 that your habitation at that address is fixed?

17 MS. CIAMACCO: Definitely.

18 MS. HUMMER: And that if you ever  
19 leave to go to other places that your intention is  
20 always to return to that address?

21 MS. CIAMACCO: Always. I get zero  
22 mail at Sandimark. My driver's license --

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So the idea of  
24 the -- that was suggested, and I think we've got

1 even documentation, that you're taking the tax  
2 credit from the Sandimark address --

3 MS. CIAMACCO: I'm not sure how it's  
4 filed at the auditor. There are two principal  
5 residences. So I've got two residences. You can  
6 have a primary and secondary, per my attorney. But  
7 I reside at both. I'm primarily at Walnut Street.  
8 I would say 90 percent of the time at Walnut  
9 Street.

10 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Is the Walnut  
11 Street residence registered as your second primary  
12 residence?

13 MS. CIAMACCO: I can't remember if  
14 that one is or if Sandimark is.

15 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Sandimark is  
16 registered by the documents as the owner occupancy  
17 tax reduction location by the Ohio Revised Code.  
18 So that would be your number one owner occupancy,  
19 is 7088 Sandimark.

20 MS. CIAMACCO: Okay. I've owned  
21 Walnut Street longer.

22 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I wonder what  
23 that's filed as.

24 MS. CIAMACCO: I don't know. Had I

1 had more than one business day to prepare for this,  
2 I could have given you everything you need. So if  
3 you tell me what you need, I'm happy to get it for  
4 you.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I thought I saw  
6 it here.

7 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: What is the  
8 Walnut Street filed as?

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: No. I mean, I  
10 saw the documentation that the other residence  
11 is -- you're claiming the owner occupied tax  
12 reduction opportunity for your principal place of  
13 residence at the -- not the Walnut, but --

14 MS. CIAMACCO: You know, I would  
15 really have to check. And the property on Walnut  
16 Street is not commercial, it's agricultural. There  
17 is a log home there. I did have to register my  
18 mother who is now 90, so she would not be able to  
19 vote right now. I moved her from her house and  
20 sold it. So she is now --

21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I want to find  
22 that document again.

23 Stew, that was in your packet of  
24 materials, wasn't it?

1 MR. FLAHERTY: It's in the packet  
2 from the auditor's office listing the ownership of  
3 Walnut Street.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: No. I mean, the  
5 tax reduction.

6 MR. FLAHERTY: The Sandimark one  
7 from the auditor is listed on that -- page two of  
8 that from the auditor where it says page two and  
9 lists the owner occupied. Walnut Street is listed  
10 as the non-personal ownership.

11 MS. CIAMACCO: Yeah. I was advised  
12 by my attorney because it is a business there with  
13 the agricultural business --

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Which one?

15 MS. CIAMACCO: The Walnut Street. I  
16 have four parcels that are attached to that.

17 -- to put it in an LLC, which is not  
18 a real estate-related LLC. It's specifically put  
19 together for the farm entity.

20 MS. HUMMER: I want to make sure we  
21 don't deviate from what is the standard. The mere  
22 fact that it's registered as an LLC as ownership is  
23 not a determination of fact of whether or not it's  
24 her residence. I want to make sure we're staying

1 on course on the determination.

2 The factors you are to consider is  
3 whether or not -- whether the residence that's  
4 being challenged is a habitation that is fixed and  
5 whether she intends to return. And that is what is  
6 before you for determination of whether or not the  
7 residence is actually subject to challenge.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Again, this is a  
9 good discussion. If you don't mind standing there  
10 for another few minutes, I want to finish reading  
11 the code, and maybe my colleagues wish to as well.

12 MS. HUMMER: And if you want to go  
13 into executive session, it may be helpful so you  
14 can actually talk to each other and be able to  
15 look -- and ask legal counsel questions.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Let's go into  
17 executive session.

18 I move that we go into executive  
19 session.

20 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I second.

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
22 properly moved and seconded.

23 All those in favor of the motion of  
24 going into executive session signify by saying aye.

1 (Vote taken.)

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
3 same sign.

4 (No response.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We're in  
6 executive session.

7 (Board in executive session at  
8 approximately 11:09 a.m.)

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We are out of  
10 executive session.

11 (Board out of executive session at  
12 approximately 11:44 a.m.)

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: The Board has  
14 examined we feel pretty closely the material before  
15 us and considered the very serious matter of  
16 challenging an elector's right to vote and  
17 subsequently stand for office and hold office.

18 We have discussed with counsel in  
19 some great detail the case law and even Supreme  
20 Court decisions which guide us; indeed, a case that  
21 this very Board and some of us has sat on and  
22 considered and lived through. We've examined the  
23 code as closely as we can and also with counsel's  
24 input, and we find the matter troubling.

1                   However, there is a very high  
2 standard to which this Board must consider -- or  
3 rather a very high standard which must be met for  
4 this Board, in my opinion, --

5                   We haven't voted. We're not allowed  
6 to do that in executive session.

7                   -- but there's a very high standard  
8 to remove somebody from the rolls. That's what I  
9 wanted to say.

10                   MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move  
11 the Board deny the challenge of the right to vote  
12 filed by R. Eric Cordray of 3734 Caracas Drive,  
13 Westerville, Ohio, and Stewart Flaherty of 4433  
14 Smothers Road, Westerville, Ohio, against Delena  
15 Ciamacco of 4531 Walnut Street, Westerville, Ohio,  
16 and order that Delena Ciamacco's registration be  
17 preserved in the Franklin County voter file.

18                   CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

19                   DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
20 properly moved and seconded.

21                   All those in favor of the motion  
22 signify by saying aye.

23                   (Vote taken.)

24                   DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,

1 same sign.

2 (No response.)

3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
4 carries.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you,  
6 gentlemen. Thank you, Ms. Ciamacco.

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Are we ready  
8 to certify or --

9 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yes.

10 MS. PATTON: I have just handed to  
11 you the official results for the August 8th, 2023,  
12 special election. These include -- these results  
13 also include the provisional ballots as well as the  
14 additional mail ballots that were received after  
15 election day and also the four ballots for the  
16 election day votes that you guys voted to accept  
17 today.

18 So in addition to what was received  
19 election night, we added 5,553 votes to the results  
20 which shows that out of 874,980 registered voters  
21 we had a turnout of 334,864 voters which is a  
22 38.27 percent turnout with the issue failing in  
23 Franklin County. We would ask that you certify the  
24 results as presented before you today.



1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Questions?

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I don't.

3 I move that the Board certify and  
4 declare as final the official canvass of the votes  
5 cast at the August 8th, 2023 special election as  
6 submitted by staff.

7 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
9 properly moved and seconded.

10 All those in favor of the motion  
11 signify by saying aye.

12 (Vote taken.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
14 same sign.

15 (No response.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
17 carries.

18 Now we're ready to do the selection  
19 of the voting location for our audit.

20 So I think we need to make a motion  
21 in order to proceed with the audit.

22 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move  
23 the Board set the post-election audit to begin  
24 September 6th, 2023, at 10 a.m. and that the audit

1 be conducted in accordance with the Secretary of  
2 State directive and be held at the Franklin County  
3 Board of Elections, 1700 Morse Road.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All in favor  
6 of the motion signify by saying aye.

7 (Vote taken.)

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
9 same sign.

10 (No response.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
12 carries.

13 I think we also need a motion above  
14 that that requires us to conduct the audit.

15 MR. MACKEY: And choose the units to  
16 be audited. Is that in there?

17 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I  
18 move -- the race for State Issue 1 requires an  
19 audit, so I move the Board conduct a 5% audit by  
20 voting location using the Location Identification  
21 numbers for each of the voting locations in  
22 Franklin County.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second.

24 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been

1 properly moved and seconded.

2 All those in favor of the motion  
3 signify by saying aye.

4 (Vote taken.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,  
6 same sign.

7 (No response.)

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion  
9 carries.

10 Jeff, I think you're up.

11 MR. MACKEY: So for our new Board  
12 member's sake, we used to roll dice to select  
13 randomly the locations to be audited. We adopted a  
14 couple of years ago a more technological approach.  
15 We found the Random dot org website that allows us  
16 to randomly select a sequence of voting locations  
17 to conduct our audit.

18 So in Franklin County at the August  
19 special election, 282 voting locations. They are  
20 numbered from 101 down to 382. So we will use  
21 those numbers to generate our sequence. We have  
22 generated randomly our sequence and type that into  
23 our handy spreadsheet here.

24 MS. PATTON: 350, 238, 211, 174,

1 360, 132, 232, 249, 168, 201, 163, 206, 262, 110,  
2 357, 274.

3 That's our 5.11%.

4 MR. MACKEY: We'll preserve this for  
5 the record.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Are we ready  
7 to move on to the certification of the candidates  
8 to the November 7th ballot?

9 MR. MACKEY: Yes.

10 We found a mistake in Exhibit C  
11 here, so I just want to swap out your Exhibit Cs.

12 MR. MACKEY: So as of the  
13 August 9th, 2023, deadline to file petitions to run  
14 for office and for questions and issues to be filed  
15 for the November 7th, 2023, general election, the  
16 Board received 211 candidate petitions including  
17 four write-in declarations. Six of those are not  
18 going to be recommended for certification, which is  
19 2.8 percent, which I think is actually a little  
20 lower than usual. So that's good. We checked  
21 26,285 some signatures between those and the  
22 statewide petitions that we also had to deal with  
23 during that time frame.

24 So before you you have Exhibit C

1 which includes 204 candidates whose petitions were  
2 timely filed and reviewed by staff and found to be  
3 valid and sufficient.

4 DIRECTOR WHITE: It's at 210 and you  
5 said 211 filed.

6 MR. MACKEY: I didn't have  
7 Ms. Ciamacco's. That was good quick math, though.

8 MEMBER SEXTON: I move the Board  
9 certify to the November 7th, 2023 general election  
10 ballot those candidates listed on Exhibit C and  
11 that these petitions were filed timely and found to  
12 be valid and sufficient.

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the  
14 motion.

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been  
16 properly moved and seconded.

17 All those in favor of the motion  
18 signify by saying aye.

19 (Vote taken.)

20 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,

1           Jeff, you mentioned there were six

3           MR. MACKEY: Staff reviewed their

8 why we are not recommending them for certification  
9 to you. If you'd like to discuss any of them.

10           MEMBER SEXTON: I'm curious how do  
11 we this, how do we inform both the candidates that  
12 got certified and those that didn't? Do we send a

14           MR. MACKEY: Send a letter to each  
15 group of candidates, and obviously we post a list  
16 of certified candidates on the website. If you

21 they just don't get valid signatures. It's so

1 on the candidate to clear that hurdle.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: You're exactly

4 I move that the Board deny

6 Exhibit D on the basis that their petitions were  
7 either not filed timely or found by staff to be  
8 invalid or insufficient and that these candidates  
9 will not appear on the November 7th, 2023, general

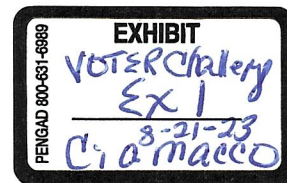

**Complaint:**

Delena Ciamacco falsely stated her residence address on her 2017 and 2023 nominating petitions for the office of Blendon Township Trustee. In both the Statement of Candidacy and in the Circulator Statement Ms. Ciamacco claimed her residence address was 4531 E. Walnut Street, Westerville. This is her business address, not her residence address. Ms. Ciamacco was made aware of this in 2017. A complaint was filed with the Board of Elections, but it was within 30 days of the election, so it was not acted upon.

Jan Heichel, a Blendon Township Trustee is on Ms. Ciamacco's 2023 committee and was a circulator of the 2023 petitions. Mrs. Heichel was party to the discussion in 2017 about the error of address that occurred with the trustees and the administrator. She was aware that the complaint was too late to be filed and aware of the fact that if the falsehood was repeated that a challenge would be filed.

As a circulator Ms. Ciamacco signed "I Delena Ciamacco, declare under penalty of election falsification that I reside at the address appearing below my signature." Since this is not true, those petitions that Ms. Ciamacco circulated should be voided. Since Mrs. Heichel knew that the address of the candidate was not the correct address, the petitions that she submitted should also be voided.

As a candidate Ms. Ciamacco signed "I, Delena Ciamacco, the undersigned, do hereby declare under penalty of election falsification that my voting residence address is 4531 E. Walnut Street, Westerville, OH 43081 and I am a qualified elector. "If Ms. Ciamacco used a business address on her voter registration, then she should not be considered a qualified elector until she corrects her residential address. Since it was incorrect on the date she filed the petition, the information on the petitions should stand as false.

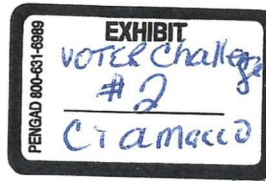

## Candidates Not Recommended for Certification

### Statement of Candidacy Not Signed

Each petition states on its face, "NOTE – THE CANDIDATE MUST FILL IN, SIGN AND DATE THIS STATEMENT OF CANDIDACY BEFORE PETITIONS ARE CIRCULATED."

R.C. 3513.09 If the petition required by section 3513.07 of the Revised Code to be filed with a declaration of candidacy consists of more than one separate petition paper, the declaration of candidacy of the candidate named need be signed by the candidate, or of an attorney in fact acting pursuant to section 3501.382 of the Revised Code, on only one of such separate petition papers, but the declaration of candidacy so signed shall be copied on each other separate petition paper before the signature of electors are placed on it.

### Incomplete/Invalid Circulator Statement

R.C. 3501.38(E)(1) On each petition paper, the circulator shall indicate the number of signatures contained on it, and shall sign a statement made under penalty of election falsification that the circulator witnessed the affixing of every signature, that all signers were to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief qualified to sign, and that every signature is to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief the signature of the person whose signature it purports to be or of an attorney in fact acting pursuant to section 3501.382 of the Revised Code.



## Candidate Petitions

The statutes prescribing the form of candidate petitions generally require substantial compliance. When there is an error or omission on a petition form, the board of elections must determine whether the prospective candidate substantially complied with the form of the petition. In determining whether a prospective candidate substantially complied with the form of the petition, the inquiry is typically fact-specific. The board should consult with its legal counsel, the county prosecutor, when reviewing petitions.

## Designation of Term

R.C. 3513.28 indicates, "...Each independent candidate for the unexpired term of any office shall designate in his statement of candidacy the date on which such unexpired term will end."

## Office

The declaration or statement of candidacy signed by the prospective candidate must identify the office sought so that both the electors signing the petition and the board of elections are able to ascertain from the petition which office the candidate seeks.
