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P R O C E E D I N G S

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3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Well, happy
4 new year. Looks like we have a quorum, but I will
5 go ahead and take roll.

6 Kim Marinello.

7 MEMBER MARINELLO: Here.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton

9 MEMBER SEXTON: Here.

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug

11 Preisse.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here.

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Meredith
14 Freedhoff.

15 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Here.

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We have a
17 quorum.

18 The first item to agenda is the
19 approval of minutes for the November 27th,
20 December 4th and December 8th meetings of the
21 Franklin County Board of Elections, and I believe
22 Erin sent out all of the minutes for your perusal.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
24 that the board approve the minutes of the

1 November 27th, December 4th and December 8th
2 meeting of the Franklin County Board of Elections
3 as submitted.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second to motion.
5 Doug Preisse, second.

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
7 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
8 the motion, signify by saying aye.

9 (Vote taken.)

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
11 same sign.

12 (No response.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
14 carries.

15 The next item on the agenda, we have
16 a couple voter challenges, and I will call on Erin
17 Gibbons. Our manager and supervisor of the voter
18 services area are both out today, so Erin's going
19 to take the lead on those, and I believe we have
20 both of the folks that filed the challenges here
21 with us today, both Sabrina and Michelle, so we'll
22 call on them as soon as Erin gives her report.
23 Thank you.

24 MS. GIBBONS: Good afternoon, board

1 members. For some background and for your first
2 voter challenge, Ms. Sabrina Davis, the challenger,
3 registered to vote at 2733 Yorkciff Road on
4 February 22nd, 2001.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Hang on a second.
6 Okay. Go ahead. I was looking at the other
7 address. Go ahead, please.

8 MS. GIBBONS: She's been registered
9 at that address and has voted regularly since that
10 time. Mr. Stoney Davis, the challenged voter,
11 originally registered through a Black Fork paper
12 registration form on September 20th, 2023. Black
13 Fork Strategies is an advocacy group that registers
14 voters through paid canvassers throughout Ohio and
15 Franklin County in particular. The quality and
16 validity of the registrations we received from this
17 group tends to be inconsistent and not always
18 accurate in terms of the voter information provided
19 on forms.

20 The identifying information provided
21 by Mr. Davis on the registration did not match with
22 DMV records, so his record was changed to inactive
23 for BMV mismatch on October 27th, 2023. Mr. Davis
24 did not vote in the November 7th, 2023 general

1 election and we have not received any follow-up to
2 the SOS Form 10-D confirmation notice that we
3 sent Mr. Davis in order to resolve the discrepancy
4 with the BMV. The voter services department
5 recommends that the board approve the challenge
6 from Ms. Sabrina Davis.

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: May I make
8 a -- on here, I believe it says Stoney Davis at
9 2722 Yorkcliff Road. Is that my -- I typed these
10 up. Did I make an error? Should it be that he was
11 registered at 2733?

12 MS. GIBBONS: It's 3733 Yorkcliff
13 Road.

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yeah. That's the
15 point I was sort of inquiring about a moment ago.
16 I --

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: My error.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Same
19 address.

20 MS. HUMMER: I just want to make
21 sure. In what manner did we attempt to notify
22 Stoney Davis? Was there anything other than
23 sending a card?

24 MS. GIBBONS: We sent out a

1 certified letter to his registration address and we
2 posted notice in the Daily Reporter.

3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Questions of the
4 board?

5 MEMBER SEXTON: So Mr. Davis hasn't
6 had any activity with the Board of Elections since
7 this October 27th, 2023?

8 MS. GIBBONS: No.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And here we have
10 his registration form, 2733 Yorkcliff Road.

11 MS. GIBBONS: I believe Ms. Sabrina
12 Davis may be here, be present as well.

13 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: If she is here,
14 are we going to hear from her?

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: If you'd
16 like to.

17 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Good afternoon.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I think that we
19 wish to swear you in.

20 (Ms. Davis placed under oath.)

21 MS. DAVIS: My name is Sabrina Davis
22 and I've lived at 2733 Yorkcliff Road since -- my
23 daughter's -- '96, 1996. She's 26 now and I have a
24 daughter that's 34. Both of them -- I'm from

1 Los Angeles, born and raised, moved here, purchased
2 this home years ago. The girls have grown,
3 graduated from college, just moved out, and
4 I'm -- I tend to watch everything. I'm an empty
5 nester with a dog, so my job is to just keep
6 managing the fort until I decide to sell and move.

7 But anyway, here is the registration
8 that came to my home. And my mailman, he's a
9 regular guy all the time, he knocked on the door.
10 Here's my name with mine and he had them both
11 together. I said, oh, and I signed the Board of
12 Elections. When I pulled them apart, Stoney, I
13 didn't even open up here 'cause no Stoney lives
14 there. Ironically, we have the same last name, and
15 Tirza Rhoden, Norma Rhoden, which they carry their
16 father's last name, and myself have lived there the
17 whole time I purchased that home.

18 So I have -- when it was mailing
19 time, those dates were accurate that the young lady
20 said. Some things came in my home and I'm like
21 only thing that comes is mines, Tirza'a and Norma's
22 every year 'cause you know our kids move and they
23 never really detached their address even though one
24 lives in Houston and one lives in Atlanta. So I go

1 what is this Stoney Davis stuff? And since we live
2 in a world that's so kind of crazy, you never know
3 what's going on, I just called. I'm 63 years old
4 as of yesterday, my birthday.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Happy birthday.

6 MS. DAVIS: Thank you. And I called
7 and got a nice person on the phone. They sent me a
8 letter and I sent the letter back along with
9 another piece of mail for Stoney Davis all in one
10 envelope. Then I get this and I go -- 'cause I
11 still work and I'm like, oh, my God. I looked at
12 the schedule, I was off, so that's why I decided,
13 sure, I need to come and clear my home 'cause,
14 honestly, I believe I'm going to be selling my home
15 after all these years and moving to Houston near my
16 children. Yes, I think that's a great idea.

17 So anyway, that's why I'm here. And
18 no Stoney Davis lives there, never have, and that's
19 why I'm here to clear myself because when I do sell
20 my home, I don't want them down there saying, well,
21 ma'am, we see -- I know it wouldn't go that far,
22 but we don't know what kind of world we live in
23 today, so I took the time to come and just say I'm
24 Sabrina Davis. I brought a ton of bills with my

1 name on it and I don't know who Stoney Davis is,
2 and you're absolutely right, and I thought about
3 the same thing.

4 When I was voting, I even saw his
5 name on the registration with my address and I
6 immediately asked the guy that was walking around
7 what should I do because I had all the papers, and
8 he told me exactly what to do. Shortly, there
9 comes that letter, I responded, and here I am here
10 now.

11 But I always -- when you go places
12 around voting time, are you registered to vote, are
13 you registered to vote and you see that all the
14 time and they sign you up, and then before you know
15 it, it's your address is on there and I couldn't
16 figure it out. I said don't they monitor that
17 somehow? But, you know, anyway, I appreciate you
18 guys' time, the board. I appreciate your guys'
19 time.

20 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, we
21 appreciate your time and appearance.

22 MS. DAVIS: Did you need this for
23 Stoney in case he appears somewhere (indicating)?

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I'm going to let

1 the staff answer that in a moment.

2 MS. GIBBONS: Yeah. We have to keep
3 it.

4 MS. DAVIS: Absolutely. This is
5 mine (indicating).

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Any questions
7 from the board or comments questions?

8 MS. DAVIS: I kind of narrowed it
9 all down. Very serious.

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, coming from
11 LA, that acting experience, you got it down.

12 MS. DAVIS: You know, it's so funny.
13 I moved here -- I don't want to take you guys'
14 time. Thirty years ago, I met a young man in
15 Los Angeles from Columbus that bragged about the
16 city. Hey, it's good for housing, schools and
17 neighborhoods. I mean, he really pumped it up and
18 he was in the service out there, and I said and we
19 were getting -- having our little thing going on
20 and LA's always been good to me and I said, oh, why
21 not. And then I come out here and I go it's much
22 cheaper. And twice I started to sell my home to go
23 back to be near my family, but since then, a lot of
24 my immediate family has passed, so it's no going

1 back to Los Angeles, but the girls have moved onto
2 Houston and Atlanta. And the one that's in
3 Atlanta, which is like a mini LA, is moving to
4 Houston. Ironically, my mother and father were
5 born in Texas, so it's a full circle here.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, thank you
7 for being here and for the --

8 MS. DAVIS: Thank you for your time.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- and Chamber of
10 Commerce. This is public record. Don't be
11 surprised if you get on TV.

12 MS. DAVIS: It's so funny because I
13 always thought that people move there from other
14 places, before you know it, what happened to Jack?
15 LA's too much for the man. He couldn't make it,
16 and that's usually what happens. You get out there
17 at an earlier age and you're just sticker shock on
18 everything, but when I came here, I was sticker
19 shocked, and this is actually my first -- my second
20 home I've purchased here and in you guys' wonderful
21 city.

22 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you.

23 MS. DAVIS: I'm going to head on
24 out, if it's okay. Mama got to go shopping.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes. All right.

2 MS. DAVIS: Thank you and God bless
3 you have. Happy New Year's to everyone.

4 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Well, I move that
5 the board approve the challenge of right to vote
6 filed by Sabrina Davis of 2733 York Cliff Road,
7 Columbus, against Stoney Davis of 2733 York Cliff
8 Road, Columbus, and order that Stoney Davis'
9 registration be removed from the Franklin County
10 Board of Elections voter file.

11 MEMBER SEXTON: Michael Sexton, I'll
12 second.

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
14 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
15 the motion, signify by saying aye.

16 (Vote taken.)

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
18 same sign.

19 (No response.)

20 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
21 carries.

22 We have a similar voter challenge
23 and I'll turn it over to Erin Gibbons.

24 MS. GIBBONS: Hello, everyone. In

1 this case, the challenger, Michelle Rattan, is
2 currently registered to vote at 5336 Norton Road
3 and has been registered at that address since
4 September 4th of 2014. She is a regular voter and
5 Mr. Gabriel Jaszcz has the -- the challenged voter
6 originally registered to vote in Franklin County in
7 1996. He registered at 5336 Norton Road on
8 February 7th of 2018. The last time Mr. Jaszcz
9 voted was in November of 2012 for the general
10 election at the early vote center. He has had no
11 voter activity in recent years that would indicate
12 that he still lives at this address. Voter
13 services recommends that the board uphold the
14 challenge from Ms. Rattan.

15 Any questions? I believe Michelle
16 is here.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Just a second. I
18 want to read this, please. This is the Gabriel
19 registration form. So is it "Mitchell" or
20 "Michelle"?

21 MS. RATTAN: "Michelle."

22 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: "Michelle."
23 Would you like to address the board?

24 MS. RATTAN: If you would like.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Sure. Why not.
2 And since you've made the trouble to come here and
3 we appreciate that, please do.

4 (Ms. Rattan placed under oath.)

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes. Please tell
6 us your story.

7 MS. RATTAN: My husband and I
8 purchased the time at 5336 Norton Road July of
9 2014. We have lived there, we are living there.
10 We're not moving. No one else is there. I'm
11 sorry. My mom lives with us now, but I have
12 Gabriel's certified letter also. I was told to
13 bring documents to show my residency. Do I need to
14 show those to anyone? Who do I give them to?

15 MS. HUMMER: Hand them to David.

16 MS. RATTAN: I also brought my title
17 'cause I don't know what shows residency.

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Okay.

19 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: That's your
20 title. We don't want to keep that.

21 MS. RATTAN: And I can't let you
22 keep my electric bill either because we just got it
23 and we haven't paid it yet.

24 MS. HUMMER: We'll just have the

1 record --

2 MS. RATTAN: I thought if you need
3 it, you can have a copy of it, sir.

4 MS. HUMMER: We'll have the record
5 reflect that the board reviewed those records and
6 identified correctly.

7 MS. RATTAN: There's a whole bunch
8 in there, ma'am. Just pull them out to see what
9 you need to see.

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And it's in our
11 notes that --

12 MS. RATTAN: So we started receiving
13 letters to Mr. Gabriel -- and I apologize, I can't
14 pronounce his last name -- for him to do the
15 absentee ballots, so on and so forth.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: You purchased
17 your home in 2014?

18 MS. RATTAN: Yes, sir.

19 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do you know who
20 owned the house before you?

21 MS. RATTAN: It was Gabriel and his
22 wife.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Here we have in
24 the staff notes that the last time he voted was

1 November of 2012, no voter activity since.

2 MS. RATTAN: So while I was voting
3 the last time, I noticed on the -- is it a list of
4 people that are allowed in your county? I looked,
5 he was still there and still at our address, so I
6 was able to contact the gentleman at the voting
7 poll place that's in charge and he was able to give
8 me a phone number to call and I was able to call
9 and spoke to a very nice lady and she sent me the
10 letter to, what is it, contest, and that's where we
11 are.

12 Any questions?

13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Questions?
14 Comments?

15 MEMBER SEXTON: I just have one. I
16 don't know if it's -- would be for staff, but it's
17 saying here he voted in 2012, but I don't know.
18 Did he vote from this address or where did he --

19 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: It says right
20 here, Michael (indicating). He voted -- well, it
21 doesn't say there, but presumably, it's that
22 address.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: I just noticed that
24 he voted at the early vote center and I'm just

1 wondering if it was from this address.

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: He lived there
3 until 2014, I think, correct?

4 MS. RATTAN: Yes.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So he probably
6 did vote from there.

7 MS. GIBBONS: I believe so since
8 it's the same precinct.

9 MEMBER SEXTON: And he lived there
10 before?

11 MS. RATTAN: Yes. He and his wife
12 are actually the ones that built my home.

13 MEMBER SEXTON: And we don't have
14 any activity since 2012?

15 MS. HUMMER: Can I ask Erin a
16 question?

17 How did you provide notice to the
18 individual that is being challenged?

19 MS. GIBBONS: We sent a certified
20 letter and we posted in the Daily Reporter.

21 MS. HUMMER: And the certified
22 letter would have been returned since it's to the
23 address that, apparently, he doesn't --

24 MS. GIBBONS: Yeah. She has a

1 certified letter.

2 MS. HUMMER: But you did post it in
3 the Daily Reporter?

4 MS. GIBBONS: Yes.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Which I read on a
6 daily basis.

7 MS. HUMMER: You and I. I think
8 we're --

9 MEMBER MARINELLO: So I'm surprised
10 you didn't see his name in there.

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: See what the
12 judges are up to.

13 Okay. Any further questions or
14 comments for Michelle?

15 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I do not.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I don't have any.

17 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman,
18 Michael Sexton. I move that the board approve the
19 challenge of right to vote filed by Michelle Rattan
20 of 5336 Norton Road, Grove City, against Gabriel
21 Jaszcz -- Jaszcz of 5336 -- 5336 Norton Road, Grove
22 City, and order that Gabriel Jaszcz's registration
23 be removed from the Franklin County BOE voting
24 file.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse.

2 Second the motion.

3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
4 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
5 the motion, signify by saying aye.

6 (Vote taken.)

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
8 same sign.

9 (No response.)

10 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
11 carries. Thank you very much.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Thank you for
13 taking the time to --

14 Ms. RATTAN: Thank you very much.

15 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- pay attention
16 and to get the record cleared up. Thank you.

17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The next
18 item to agenda is the certification of candidates
19 for the March 19th, 2024 primary election, and I
20 will turn that over to Jeff Mackey, who is the
21 manager of our petitions and filings department.

22 MR. MACKEY: Good afternoon. The
23 Board of Elections received 344 candidate
24 petitions, of which 329 now appear on Exhibit A.

1 Exhibit A excludes the petitions of the three board
2 members who are also running for office. We
3 reviewed all the petitions, found them to be timely
4 filed, valid and sufficient.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I wonder if
6 this -- is this related to --

7 MR. MACKEY: I would note on your
8 exhibit there of the recommended certification,
9 Deborah Abbott has, just an hour and a half ago,
10 notified us that she is withdrawing from the State
11 Central Committee race in the 16th District. I
12 provided the court reporter with an updated
13 exhibit, but I still have her on your exhibit.

14 MS. HUMMER: If it's on the exhibit
15 that they are looking at, they'll have to move to
16 amend the exhibit and remove that name.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: There's a
18 difference between the exhibit we're looking at and
19 the one --

20 MR. MACKEY: For the official
21 record.

22 MS. HUMMER: So I think there's a
23 request to -- or motion to amend the exhibit to
24 remove Deborah Abbott, he said, from Exhibit A.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Where is
2 Deborah Abbott on here?

3 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Page 9 at the
4 bottom.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Then I will, Doug
6 Preisse, move to remove the name of Deborah Abbott,
7 candidate for Republican State Central Committee,
8 16th District, from Exhibit A of today's board
9 meeting.

10 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
12 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
13 the motion, signify by saying aye.

14 (Vote taken.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
16 same sign.

17 (No response.)

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
19 carries.

20 MR. MACKEY: Staff recommends
21 everyone else on that exhibit for approval
22 certification.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay.

24 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the

1 board certify the March 19th, 2024 primary election
2 ballot of those candidates listed on Exhibit A and
3 that these petitions were filed timely and found to
4 be valid and sufficient.

5 MS. HUMMER: Exhibit A as amended.

6 MEMBER MARINELLO: As amended.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse,
8 second.

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
10 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
11 the motion, signify by saying aye.

12 (Vote taken.)

13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
14 same sign.

15 (No response.)

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
17 carries.

18 As you mentioned --

19 MR. MACKEY: We also have reviewed
20 the petition of Kimberly Marinello, candidate for
21 Democratic County Central Committee for Columbus
22 Ward 49. Found her petition to be timely filed,
23 valid and sufficient.

24 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: So I think

1 probably a motion to accept --

2 MEMBER SEXTON: A motion to accept
3 Kim Marinello for 49.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Can I vote no
5 or --

6 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I second.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Traitor.

8 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I like Kim, yes.

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
10 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor
11 signify by saying --

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do you want to do
13 a roll call?

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Probably
15 ought to do roll call.

16 Kim Marinello.

17 MEMBER MARINELLO: Abstain.

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug
19 Preisse.

20 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes.

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Meredith
22 Freedhoff.

23 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Yes.

24 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Mike

1 Sexton.

2 MEMBER SEXTON: Yes.

3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
4 carries.

5 MR. MACKEY: Staff has reviewed the
6 petition of Douglas Preisse, Republican County
7 Central Committee candidate for Columbus Ward 2.
8 Found his petition to be timely filed and valid and
9 sufficient.

10 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman,
11 Meredith Freedhoff. I'd like to move that we
12 accept that ballot.

13 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I'll buy you a
15 drink.

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
17 properly moved and seconded. I'll go ahead and
18 take roll.

19 Kim Marinello.

20 MEMBER MARINELLO: Yes.

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton.

22 MEMBER SEXTON: Yes.

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug

24 Preisse.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Abstain.

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Meredith
3 Freedhoff.

4 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Yes.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
6 carries.

7 MR. MACKEY: Staff finally reviewed
8 the petition of Meredith Freedhoff, a candidate for
9 Republican State Central Committee for the 16th
10 District. Found her petition to be timely filed,
11 valid and sufficient.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I would move to
13 accept and certify that submission.

14 MEMBER SEXTON: Second.

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
16 properly moved and seconded. I'll go ahead and
17 take roll.

18 Kim Marinello.

19 MEMBER MARINELLO: Yes.

20 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Mike Sexton.

21 MEMBER SEXTON: Yes.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Doug
23 Preisse.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes.

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: And Meredith
2 Freedhoff.

3 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Abstain.

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE:
5 Congratulations.

6 Next item on the agenda is the
7 denial of certification of candidates, and I'll
8 again turn that over to Jeff Mackey for Exhibit B.

9 MR. MACKEY: Exhibit B has ten
10 candidates whose petitions staff found either to be
11 invalid or insufficient. We do not recommend that
12 these candidates be certified to the 2024 primary
13 election ballot. Information is detailed there,
14 but if you have additional questions, I can just go
15 with that.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And there was a
17 little bit of back and forth, but just sort of for
18 clarification, if somebody files, as these persons
19 on Exhibit B have done and are denied access to the
20 ballot for various deficiencies hereto described,
21 they cannot run as a write-in; is that correct?

22 MR. MACKEY: That is correct.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: According to the
24 Ohio Revised Code.

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: For this
2 office.

3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: For the same
4 office.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I have another
6 question.

7 Can they challenge this?

8 MR. MACKEY: They can always ask the
9 board to reconsider their decision if you decide to
10 not certify them.

11 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So they would
12 have to -- well, we would have to have talked to
13 them if they would request -- maybe id they could
14 question the signature? They can't do that after
15 this is certified?

16 MR. MACKEY: The board is welcome to
17 hear any request for reconsideration that a
18 candidate who is not certified may pose before you,
19 yes.

20 MS. HUMMER: And we will provide
21 you, as we have in the past, with the legal
22 guidance if that comes forward on the -- on your
23 discretion and what you can and cannot do.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, based

1 upon -- are there any questions?

2 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I asked mine.

3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I have no
4 further.

5 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Anymore
6 questions?

7 MEMBER SEXTON: Just had one.

8 On Michael Wedekind, it says the
9 deficiency, the petition for candidate section on
10 the petition is mostly absent.

11 MR. MACKEY: Yes.

12 MEMBER SEXTON: What is mostly
13 absent?

14 MR. MACKEY: First line is there,
15 but there's an entire paragraph after the first
16 line that is missing from the petition that
17 includes information that the signers of the
18 petition are signing an agreement with. There's a
19 paragraph at the bottom two inches of that I don't
20 think I included.

21 MS. HUMMER: Can you describe what
22 is missing for the court reporter?

23 MR. MACKEY: I think I brought a
24 copy of the petition. I'll go grab -- well, here's

1 my complete petition here. So the part that is
2 missing says: We, the undersigned, qualified
3 electors of the State of Ohio whose voting
4 residence is in the county, city, village or
5 township and members of the democratic party hereby
6 certify that Michael Todd Wedekind, whose
7 declaration of candidacy is filed herewith, is, in
8 our opinion, well qualified to perform the duties
9 of the office or position to which a person desires
10 to be elected.

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So the reverse
12 side, he has everything necessary, but on the front
13 side, he's missing the bottom part you just
14 described?

15 MR. MACKEY: Right. He has
16 basically printed a 14-inch document on 11-inch
17 paper, so the bottom three inches are missing.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: What's missing on
19 the first side?

20 MR. MACKEY: There's an area for the
21 circulator to include their address, but that's not
22 a requirement of a regular local candidate
23 petition.

24 MEMBER SEXTON: I would just make a

1 note, we should probably, in the future -- I mean,
2 we've been through this several times with
3 candidates in the past. You know they go to the
4 board's website, they print it out and then it's
5 not complete because it's on 8-and-a-half-by-11
6 paper and they see there's no option to sign it
7 'cause it's cut off, so I don't know how we correct
8 that in the future, but I know this happened
9 several times in 2020 and --

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: This is
11 a -- our -- excuse me, Mr. Chairman. This
12 declaration of candidacy is a prescribed document
13 by the Secretary of State, correct?

14 MEMBER SEXTON: That's my
15 understanding.

16 DIRECTOR WHITE: Correct.

17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We could try to
18 find an 8-and-a-half-by- -- a shorter version.

19 MR. MACKEY: And we also accept
20 8-and-a-half-by-11 in petitions, but have to
21 be -- has to be resized to fit the entire petition
22 to there.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Does our
24 website --

1 MR. MACKEY: It does indicate it's
2 supposed to be printed on 14-inch paper.

3 DIRECTOR WHITE: There's an
4 instruction when you go to print the petition, if
5 choose to do so on your phone, there's an
6 instruction to print it on 8-and-a-half-by-14
7 duplex two-sided. Some people -- most people
8 follow that instruction and some don't, so that's
9 the circumstance that you have here is that
10 instruction wasn't followed and so that portion of
11 the petition was cut off.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well -- and it
13 was filed -- or, rather, it was followed on the
14 two-sidedness, but not on the length.

15 DIRECTOR WHITE: Correct.

16 MEMBER SEXTON: Right. That would
17 have been here (indicating).

18 MR. MACKEY: And we're in the middle
19 of redesigning that whole section of our website
20 'cause the technology is no longer acceptable to
21 the data center, so we'll further highlight that.

22 MS. HUMMER: And I think what you're
23 saying is maybe when you go to print, that there's
24 something that flashes that says, are you using

1 8-by-14 or something like that.

2 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yeah. We'll have
3 to be more explicit.

4 MEMBER SEXTON: Or a required field
5 where if you don't fill out 8-and-a-half-by-14, it
6 won't print it or something like that.

7 Okay. Thank you.

8 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Can I ask you one
9 more question? Are these candidates notified by
10 the board?

11 MR. MACKEY: Yes. Got the letters
12 printed already and they'll go out this afternoon.

13 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Thank you.

14 MEMBER SEXTON: And you said they do
15 have a five-day period if they want to?

16 MR. MACKEY: They have as long as
17 they want, but eventually the ballots will be
18 printed and we'll start voting and stuff.

19 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman,
20 Meredith Freedhoff. I move that the board deny
21 certification to candidates listed on Exhibit B,
22 and that these candidates will not appear in the
23 March 19, 2024 primary election ballot.

24 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
2 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
3 the motion, signify by saying aye.

4 (Vote taken.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
6 same sign.

7 (No response.)

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
9 carries.

10 The next item to agenda is the
11 certification of issues on Exhibit C. And, again,
12 I'll turn that over to Jeff Mackey.

13 MR. MACKEY: Exhibit C includes
14 seven questions that were filed with our office. I
15 shouldn't really have included those last two that
16 were filed in Pickaway County and Madison County.
17 I apologize. So the first seven there.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Well, do we need
19 to amend this exhibit as well because we're not
20 authorized to --

21 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yeah. I would do
22 that.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: -- to confirm?

24 MR. MACKEY: The board doesn't

1 actually need to certify these. We always do out
2 of just recognizing that they have been filed with
3 us and that they're going to appear on the ballot.

4 MS. HUMMER: If they're going to
5 take action on it, then they have to take action
6 with the correct document.

7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So let's -- I
8 think what I'm hearing from counsel is we're going
9 to move to modify Exhibit C to strike the Teays
10 Valley Local School District issue and the
11 Madison-Plains Local School District issue from
12 Exhibit C, and I so move.

13 MEMBER MARINELLO: Second.

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
15 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
16 the motion, signify by saying aye.

17 (Vote taken.)

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
19 same sign.

20 (No response.)

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
22 carries.

23 MEMBER SEXTON: And I would move
24 that the board certify Exhibit C as amended.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: To the
2 March 19th, 2024?

3 MEMBER SEXTON: Yes.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And I'll second.

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
6 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
7 the motion signify, by saying aye.

8 (Vote taken.)

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
10 same sign.

11 (No response.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
13 carries.

14 Again, I'll turn it over to Jeff
15 Mackey for the certification of local options on
16 Exhibit D.

17 MR. MACKEY: The board also received
18 seven petitions for local options. One of the
19 questions posed both a weekday and Sunday sales
20 option. The Westerville 5-C local option for the
21 North High Brewing Company. The rest were all
22 Sunday sales. Staff reviewed those petitions along
23 with legal counsel and found them to be timely
24 filed, valid and sufficient.

1 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the
2 board certify to the March 19th, 2024 primary
3 election ballot, those local options listed on
4 Exhibit D, and that these local options were filed
5 timely and found to be valid and sufficient.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse,
7 second the motion.

8 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
9 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
10 the motion, signify by saying aye.

11 (Vote taken.)

12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
13 same sign.

14 (No response.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
16 carries.

17 The next item on the agenda is, from
18 time to time, we get a request from candidates to
19 appear on the ballot with a different time from
20 which they were registered, so, again, I'll turn
21 that over to Jeff Mackey.

22 MR. MACKEY: So a candidate's
23 nickname may be printed on the ballot.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Hang on.

1 Where are we?

2 MS. GIBBONS: Request for alternate
3 ballot names.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. We only
5 have one?

6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: We have one.

7 MR. MACKEY: So nicknames may be
8 printed on the ballot if a nickname is a natural
9 derivative of the candidate's legal name.
10 Generally, we handle this administratively if
11 they're like "Bob" for "Robert," "Bill" for
12 "William." Ms. Sharrah is registered as Besmira
13 Sharrah. She's a candidate --

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Do we have paper
15 on this, or no?

16 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: No.

17 MEMBER MARINELLO: I don't have
18 anything.

19 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. I'm sorry.
20 Go ahead, please.

21 MR. MACKEY: Besmira Sharrah, who is
22 registered as "Besmira Sharrah" is a candidate for
23 the 16th Ohio senate seat, has written us a letter,
24 I thought you had, but it says: I hope this letter

1 finds you well. I'm writing to inform you of a
2 request regarding my name that I would like to
3 appear on the ballot for the upcoming election. My
4 legal name is Besmira Sharrah, B-E-S-M-I-R-A,
5 however, I am generally known and referred to as
6 Besa Sharrah, B-E-S-A. I kindly request that my
7 name be listed as Besa Sharrah on the ballot, as
8 this is the name by which I am commonly recognized.
9 I understand that the accuracy of the information
10 on the ballot is of the utmost importance. I
11 appreciate your attention to this matter. If there
12 are any additional steps or documents required of
13 this process, this request, please let me know and
14 I will promptly provide them. Thank you for your
15 understanding and assistance in this matter. I
16 look forward to participating in the upcoming
17 election as "Besa Sharrah."

18 MEMBER MARINELLO: Would you say
19 again her legal name?

20 MR. MACKEY: Besmira, B-E-S-M-I-R-A.

21 MEMBER MARINELLO: Who is Vera? Did
22 you say "Vera" ever?

23 DIRECTOR WHITE: "Besmira."

24 MR. MACKEY: No, "Besmira."

1 DIRECTOR WHITE: Full legal name.

2 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I can speak with
3 some small authority being half Albanian, I think,
4 alone on the board. And Besa is, indeed, a native
5 of Albania, and I've known her for many, many years
6 only as "Besa." To the extent that Besa is a
7 derivative of "Besmira" in Albanian, which I can
8 tell you it is, I think it holds that it probably
9 stands to reason that it would be in English as
10 well, so now you have my --

11 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move
12 that the board accept the name change of
13 "Besmira Sharrah" to "Besa Sharrah" as an
14 alternative of -- alternate ballot name for the
15 March 19th, 2024 primary election ballot.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: (Speaking foreign
17 language.)

18 I second the motion.

19 MEMBER MARINELLO: Are you showing
20 off now?

21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I am.

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
23 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
24 the motion, signify by saying aye.

1 (Vote taken.)

2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
3 same sign.

4 (No response.)

5 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
6 carries. Thank you, Jeff.

7 The next item on the agenda is the
8 E.E. Ward contract extension, and that's the
9 company that loads and transports our voting
10 equipment to and from the polling locations. So
11 I'll turn that over to Director White.

12 DIRECTOR WHITE: Thank you, David.

13 Good afternoon. This is just our
14 standard extension with E.E. Ward. This is our
15 third extension for this transportation contract.
16 We originally entered into this agreement in the
17 summer of 2020, so this is our last extension on
18 this contract. And so pending the board's
19 approval, once we do get approval on this, we'll
20 have to go back out to bid for a new transportation
21 vendor, and we're currently working with the
22 purchasing department to do that. So pending any
23 questions, we'd ask that you approve this contract.

24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I've asked this

1 question every time the issue comes up and
2 repeatedly, for many, many years you guys have said
3 they do a good job.

4 DIRECTOR WHITE: They do a fantastic
5 job.

6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I think they've
7 changed ownership, haven't they?

8 DIRECTOR WHITE: No. Not since I've
9 been here, they've not. Yeah.

10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay.

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: As a matter
12 of fact, they were the answer to a Jeopardy
13 question not long ago. They are the longest
14 minority-owned business in the United States of
15 America.

16 MEMBER MARINELLO: Wow. I didn't
17 know that and I watch Jeopardy.

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: That's great.
19 Well, let's see. Who's up? Meredith, if you're
20 satisfied, or do you have any questions?

21 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: I have no
22 questions.

23 Mr. Chairman, Meredith Freedhoff. I
24 move that the board authorize the director and

1 deputy director to enter into a contact with
2 E.E. Ward for a period of one year, January 1, '24
3 to December 31, '24 for the loading and transport
4 of election equipment to and from polling locations
5 in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.

6 MEMBER MARINELLO: I second.

7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
8 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
9 the motion, signify by saying aye.

10 (Vote taken.)

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
12 same sign.

13 (No response.)

14 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
15 carries.

16 The next item on the agenda is the
17 purchase of poll worker training manuals, and I
18 will turn that over to Chris Bender, the supervisor
19 of our precinct election officials department to
20 explain what those are.

21 MR. BENDER: This is the printing of
22 the manuals we use to train poll workers for every
23 election. We've used Hopkins Printing probably
24 since as long as I've been here, if not longer, so

1 probably a good four or five years. They are
2 consistently the most affordable vendor that we've
3 reached out to. They have great customer service
4 and we have had no issues with them going forward.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: They're local
6 here?

7 MR. BENDER: Yes.

8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Oh, yeah.
9 Citygate Drive, Columbus.

10 MEMBER MARINELLO: No questions?

11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Not from me.

12 MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the
13 board authorize the purchase of 5,000 poll worker
14 training manuals for the March 2024 primary
15 election in the amount of in \$33,500.

16 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse,
17 second the motion.

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
19 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
20 the motion, signify by saying aye.

21 (Vote taken.)

22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
23 same sign.

24 (No response.)

1 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
2 carries. Thank you, Chris.

3 Next item on the agenda is the Blue
4 ware software licensing amendment agreement. I
5 will turn that over the Matt Kelly, who is the
6 manager of absentee department to explain what that
7 is.

8 MR. KELLY: Good afternoon,
9 Mr. Chairman and members of the board. In front of
10 you is an annual maintenance agreement that we have
11 with our vendor for our ReliaVote system,
12 BlueCrest. The amended version from last year
13 includes a 3.1 percent price increase that's
14 represented by the request of \$99,957.44. This
15 covers the annual parts agreement that we have with
16 the company, so when we have a part break down on
17 the machine, we have approximately \$15,000
18 allocated for those additional parts. We're doing
19 preventive maintenance on the machine in January,
20 and, again, we'll do preventive maintenance check
21 on the machine during our down time in the summer.
22 This also includes our annual license fee for the
23 software or the operating systems for both the
24 inserter and the sorter as well as labor coverage

1 for our technician that we have onsite during the
2 election for the setup and both for the first day
3 that we run ballots. We also use the technician
4 for the maintenance in the summertime and the
5 maintenance pre-election every cycle.

6 So before you is the request for
7 \$99,957.44 for this year's annual agreement with
8 BlueCrest, and I ask for your approval.

9 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Thank you,
10 Matt.

11 DIRECTOR WHITE: Thanks, Matt.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We're happy with
13 them?

14 MR. KELLY: We're happy with them
15 and we're upgrading the software as well. They
16 were at Pitney Bowes company and they were spun off
17 to a new company called BlueCrest, and they are
18 sunsetting the Pitney Bowes software because Pitney
19 Bowes doesn't make the software anymore, so they've
20 created their own software, so we're installing
21 that later this month. That was something the
22 board approved last year.

23 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Okay. And what
24 is covered under election labor coverage? That's a

1 very high number there.

2 MR. KELLY: Right. There's a local
3 technician, the company has a local technician who
4 services a wide variety of companies. In fact, the
5 county uses him at their mailroom downtown as well.
6 He comes in and if there's a major malfunction with
7 the system, he can install the parts, he can help
8 our -- our two ballot technicians that we have here
9 onsite, our full-time employees, he helps them with
10 the election setup of the machine, and our D&R
11 staff, our two staff that are back there with him
12 at all times make sure that, you know, he's there
13 checking all the machine parts so the machine runs
14 and is tested properly. We make sure that
15 BlueCrest has a technician onsite the very first
16 day we run ballots to make sure nothing happens,
17 and then if we need him every single day that we're
18 running ballots, he will be here for that.

19 Chances are, when we have a smaller
20 primary election, we don't need him every single
21 day, but we budget for those technician hours. If
22 we just billed by the hour, I believe it's close to
23 \$400 an hour for the technician, so this represents
24 a block of those hours.

1 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: So you may use
2 it, you may not?

3 MR. KELLY: We probably will use it
4 in 2024, yeah.

5 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Thank you.

6 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Mr. Chairman,
7 Michael Sexton. I move that the board authorize
8 the director and deputy director to amend the
9 existing maintenance contract, BlueCrest, for the
10 updating of the ReliaVote software and maintenance
11 on the sorter and inserter in the amount of
12 \$99,957.44. This contract amendment will begin
13 January 1 of 2024 and end December 31st, 2024.

14 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse,
15 second the motion.

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
17 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
18 the motion, signify by saying aye.

19 (Vote taken.)

20 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
21 same sign.

22 (No response.)

23 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
24 carries.

1 The next item on the agenda is the
2 promotion of Chad Fracker, and I'll turn that over
3 to Director White.

4 DIRECTOR WHITE: Thank you, David.

5 Chad Fracker is our customer service
6 liaison. He came to the board this year and
7 made -- we hired him on as a full-time member of
8 our staff, democratic member of our staff. He
9 works out front. He helps to manage our front
10 desk, our call center, call volume when we have to
11 bring on additional employees to manage calls, he
12 works with security. And so he's been a great
13 employee, and so with the upcoming election, 2024
14 presidential election, and the purchase of the new
15 Tenex touch pads, which the board approved back in
16 November, we wanted to take an opportunity to put
17 some additional staff in our election operations
18 department and we feel that with the new touch pads
19 and the new e-poll books, there's a necessity
20 there. So we're asking Chad to move to that
21 department and to work with Carla and her team and
22 help manage election operations. So we're excited
23 to have him move, and pending any questions, we ask
24 for approval.

1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And Chad is a
2 democrat or republican?

3 DIRECTOR WHITE: He's a democrat.

4 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: And what does
5 that do with the balance of our numerical R and Ds?

6 DIRECTOR WHITE: So currently,
7 there's a full-time republican and democrat in that
8 department. And so for our 2024 budget, we made a
9 request and were approved some additional full-time
10 positions, four to be exact, and so I think David
11 and I had talked and we wanted to put another
12 republican and democrat in that department because
13 of the necessity of work volume and necessity of
14 the presidential election coming up, so this would
15 fill one of the spots.

16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: But it's
17 still 26/26, if that's --

18 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: That was sort of
19 my question.

20 DIRECTOR WHITE: Oh, yeah. I
21 apologize. The balance of employees stays the
22 same.

23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So he's getting
24 out of the oil exploration business and getting

1 into elections?

2 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yes.

3 MEMBER MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I
4 move that the board promote Chad Fracker to work as
5 an election operations specialist in the election
6 operations department at a rate of 24.76 per hour
7 and that this promotion be made effective as of
8 December 18th, 2023.

9 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Doug Preisse,
10 second the motion.

11 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
12 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
13 the motion, signify by saying aye.

14 (Vote taken.)

15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed,
16 same sign.

17 (No response.)

18 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
19 carries. That's a -- it was a little higher
20 initially and it's a great promotion.

21 The next item on the agenda is the
22 BOE full-time employee pay raise. As the board
23 members are probably aware, the county
24 commissioners authorized a three percent

1 across-the-board pay raise for all non-bargaining
2 employees at the county level. They additionally
3 offered a one percent merit pay, which is reflected
4 in Exhibit E, so I would ask you to take a look at
5 that, and any questions you could ask either myself
6 or Director White.

7 So Exhibit E does reflect that every
8 full-time employee here got a three percent
9 across-the-board raise, and I believe there were 11
10 republicans that split the one percent and seven or
11 so democrats that did the same.

12 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Good with me.
13 Questions from the board?

14 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman,
15 Meredith Freedhoff. I move that the board approve
16 a pay increase to all full-time BOE staff as shown

21 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been
22 properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of
23 the motion, signify by saying aye.

4 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Motion
5 carries.

6 I don't believe there are anymore

The board should consult with its legal counsel, the county prosecutor, when reviewing petitions.

Office

The declaration or statement of candidacy signed by the prospective candidate must identify the office sought so that both the electors signing the petition and the board of elections are able to ascertain from the petition which office the candidate seeks.




