FRANKLIN COUNTY SPECIAL ELECTION FINAL RESULTS

For Immediate Release Aug. 4, 2009

(Columbus) Voters went to the polls today for a special election in Franklin County to decide an income tax increase for the city of Columbus and whether to increase a property tax levy for the South-Western City School District.

Final unofficial Franklin County only returns show the following:

- 110,167 of 595,090 eligible for today's election countywide voted for a turnout of 18.5 percent.
- 88,171 votes were cast on the Columbus income tax issue.
- 32,444 votes were cast on the South-Western Schools property tax levy.

There were 1,619 provisional ballots cast today.
