## **Franklin County General Election Results**

**(Columbus)** Results released this morning by the board of elections show 30.7 percent of eligible Franklin County voters cast ballots in yesterday's general election.

Unofficial returns have 258,524 of 842,181 eligible voting on Tuesday with 4,937 provisional ballots cast and 40,650 absentee ballots received by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

Three state constitutional amendments, candidates for municipal court and a children services levy appeared on ballots countywide. Local ballot issues included elections for council, school board, tax levies and liquor options.

Fifteen write-in candidates were eligible for election to various offices. Elections for an unexpired term on the Columbus School Board and for Bexley City Auditor involved write-in candidates exclusively.
