Register By Monday to Vote in Primary

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters they must be registered by this Monday, February 6 to be eligible for the March 6, 2012 primary election. Our office is located at 280 East Broad Street and will be open for registration until 9 p.m. Monday night.

It's possible to download a registration form online http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov, request a form by calling us at (614) 525-3100 or register at the following other locations:

- Franklin County Treasurer's Office
- Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Offices
- Ohio Secretary of State's Office
- Public Libraries, public high schools and vocational schools
- All agencies providing public assistance or disability programs

Registered voters who have moved should update their home address with the board by the registration deadline. Others may need to re-register if they have not voted since 2004, have changed their legal name or if they were jailed for a felony conviction and have since been released.

Registrations returned by mail must be postmarked by Feb. 6

Registration is open to U.S. citizens who've lived in Franklin County thirty days prior to the election and who will be at least 18 years old on or before the Nov. 6 general election. Voters who are 17 years old and meet other registration requirements may vote for candidates-but not issues- in the primary election.
