**One Week Remaining to Vote Absentee  
Voting Scheduled Tomorrow at Board of Elections**

**(Columbus)** The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters that one week remains to vote absentee for the March 6 primary election.

The board of elections will be open for in-person absentee voting tomorrow, Saturday, February, 25 from 8:00 a.m. to noon. Early voting will resume Monday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through Thursday- and will extend by one hour from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2- the last day of the absentee voting period.

Voters must request an absentee ballot to receive one for the primary. Applications to vote by mail are available on our Web site <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> or by calling us at (614) 525-3100.

**Important Dates to Remember:**

- Absentee ballots returned in person must be received by the board of elections by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
- Absentee ballots returned by mail within the United States must be postmarked by March 5 and received by March 16.
- Out-of-country military and civilian absentee ballots must be received by March 16.
