## General Election Registration Deadline Tomorrow

- Agencies providing public assistance or disability programs
- Public Libraries
- Franklin County Treasurer's office.

Voters who have changed their name or address may need to update their registration by tomorrow's deadline in order to vote a regular ballot in the general election. Voters may do so when they register in person or online at www.MyOhioVote.com .

Registration is open to those U.S. citizens who are living in Franklin County thirty days before the election and will be at least 18 years old by Election Day. More than 796,000 voters are registered in Franklin County for the general election.
