Franklin County Holds Primary Election Tomorrow Polls Open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

(Columbus) Candidates for municipal office, tax issues and local liquor options will be on the ballot tomorrow when Franklin County holds its primary election for 2015.

There is no countywide issue on the ballot. The latest totals show more than 605,000 voters will have an election, but another 203,000 will not because there are no issues in their precinct or enough candidates necessary to narrow the field for the general election.

Columbus voters will nominate non-partisan candidates for mayor, city council and school board, Gahanna will hold a non-partisan primary for mayor and Reynoldsburg will hold a Republican primary for city attorney and council. Tax issues will appear on ballots in the Villages of Minerva Park and Valleyview in addition to Hamilton, Madison, Perry and Plain Townships. Local liquor options will be on ballots throughout Columbus.

Voters are encouraged to check their <u>sample ballot</u> on our Web site to determine if they have an election tomorrow. Precincts with an election will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Election results will be posted <u>online</u> after the polls close and will be updated throughout the evening.
