Franklin County Board of Elections Certifies Special Election <u>Remainder of General Election Ballot Set</u>

(Columbus) The Franklin County Board of Elections certified results of the August 8 special election yesterday and certified additional candidates and issues for the November 7 general election ballot.

Official totals for Minerva Park and Madison-Plains can be found on are website <u>http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</u>. Voters in Minerva Park passed a tax levy and voters in Madison-Plains rejected a school levy.

The Board of Elections verified 20,000 signatures and certified 224 candidates to the November 7, 2017 ballot. Two statewide issues will appear on the ballot along with a countywide Franklin County Developmental Disabilities levy.

There will be school levies in New Albany Plains, Upper Arlington, Delaware Area Career Center, and Madison-Plains. The latter two are overlaps which have areas stretching into Franklin County.

Levies for police will be on the ballot in Valleyview, Mifflin Township, and Sharon Township. One levy specific to fire will take place in Jefferson Township.

Two charter amendments will be voted on in Grove City and Reynoldsburg along with a referendum in Minerva Park and voters in Franklin Township will vote on home rule.
