**(Columbus)** Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins tomorrow for the May 8, 2018 Primary Election. In-person early voting will run from Tuesday, April 10, 2018 through Monday, May 7, 2018 and take place at the Franklin County Board of Elections located at 1700 Morse Road at the following times:

Weekdays, April 10 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through April 27 Final week, April 30 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. through May 4 Saturday, May 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday, May 6 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday, May 7 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
