Early Voting for November 8 General Election Begins Tomorrow

(**Columbus**) Absentee voting, both in-person and by mail, begins tomorrow October 12 for the November 8, 2022 General Election. As of today, more than 92,000 absentee ballots have been requested in Franklin County. Those will begin hitting the mail tomorrow to coincide with the first day of early voting. Below are the in-person voting hours that Franklin County registered voters can vote at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus.

- Weekdays, October 12 through October 28 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Saturday, October 29 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Final week, October 31 through November 4 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, November 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, November 6 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 7 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Registered voters can view their sample ballot by visiting our website at http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov. Voters planning to cast a ballot by mail must request one by noon on November 5.

Applications are available online at http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov as well at public libraries or by calling the Board of Elections at (614) 525-3470.

Voters can track and receive notifications on their mailed ballot status by going to https://ballottrax.franklincountyohio.gov/voter/. You can sign up and receive notifications via email, SMS (text) or voice. If you have already signed up, you will get update via email, text, or voice mail depending on what you set up.

Election Day is Tuesday, November 8, 2022 polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.
