

## NOTICE OF ELECTION ON ISSUE OF BONDS

R.C.133.18, 3501.11(G)

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Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Columbus, Ohio passed on the 28th day of January, 2019, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 7th day of May, 2019, the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of four hundred and twenty five million dollars (\$425,000,000) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, and improving infrastructure for the Department of Public Service, including streets and highways and refuse collection, acquiring real estate and interests in real estate, landscaping and otherwise improving the sites thereof, and acquiring furnishings, equipment and appurtenances. The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 16 years. The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.233 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 2.33 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2020.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
