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Page 3 1 PROCEEDINGS 2 3 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: I would like to call the Franklin County Board of 5 Elections Commission to order. 6 May we have the roll call. MR. DAMSCHRODER: Mr. Colley? 8 MR. COLLEY: Here. 9 MR. DAMSCHRODER: Ms. Marinello? 10 11 MS. MARINELLO: Here. MR. DAMSCHRODER: Ms. Petree? 12 MS. PETREE: Here. 13 MR. DAMSCHRODER: Chairman 14 15 Anthony? CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Here. 16 17 MR. DAMSCHRODER: All members 18 are present. Mr. Chairman, the first item on 19 the agenda for this special meeting is 20 that a challenge of Right To Vote for 21 Registration list was filed pursuant 22 23 to 3505.24. A copy of that challenge is

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in your packet.

1 We sent a notice to both the

- 2 individual who filed the challenge,
- 3 Christine F. Donaldson of 912 Bryden Road
- 4 and also to the person who was challenged,
- 5 Lawrence Anderson, purportedly of 912
- 6 Bryden Road.
- 7 According to the challenge filed
- 8 by Ms. Donaldson, Mr. Anderson does not
- 9 live at that address and has not lived at
- 10 that address for sometime. Mr. Anderson
- 11 is in our files as an inactive voter. He
- 12 has not voted for a number of years and,
- 13 based on the conversations with Patrick
- 14 Piccininni earlier this week and based on
- 15 a review of the Board's records, we do
- 16 have the statutory ability, if this board
- 17 chooses, to cancel Mr. Anderson's voter
- 18 registration on voter rolls, granting Ms.
- 19 Donaldson's challenge if the Board so
- 20 chooses.
- 21 That would be the Staff's
- 22 recommendation. The reason for a special
- 23 meeting, the law requires the Board within
- 24 ten days of the filing of a challenge to

- 1 rule on it. The challenge was filed two
- 2 days ago, and we will have to figure how
- 3 to pull the Board together next week or
- 4 very soon the following week.
- 5 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Does Mr. Bob
- 6 Anderson have a right to come in and
- 7 challenge this?
- 8 MR. DAMSCHRODER: Yes. We sent
- 9 a notice to him by forwarded mail to 912
- 10 Bryden Road and it has not been returned.
- 11 Obviously, Mr. Anderson is not here.
- 12 Based on a review of the
- 13 Auditor's records it appears that Mr. And
- 14 Mrs. Anderson lived at that address in the
- 15 1970s. They have moved. Mrs. Anderson is
- 16 listed at a different address here in
- 17 Franklin County.
- 18 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Has he voted?
- MR. DAMSCHRODER: Not for a
- 20 number of years.
- MS. MARINELLO: How did the
- 22 Donaldsons know?
- Were they getting notices there?
- MR. DAMSCHRODER: Yes. The

- 1 Donaldsons have owned the house, according
- 2 to her challenge, since the 1970s. When
- 3 we mailed the National Voter Registration
- 4 Act confirmation cards this summer
- 5 Ms. Donaldson got a card with
- 6 Mr. Anderson's name on it.
- 7 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: I will
- 8 entertain a motion.
- 9 MS. MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I
- 10 move that the Board grant the Challenge of
- 11 Right to Vote and Correction of
- 12 Registration List filed by Christine F.
- 13 Donaldson of 912 Bryden Road against
- 14 Lawrence Anderson purportedly of 912
- 15 Bryden Road and order that Mr. Anderson's
- 16 registration be immediately cancelled in
- 17 Franklin County and his name be stricken
- 18 from the Registration List.
- 19 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Is there a
- 20 second?
- MS. PETREE: Second.
- 22 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All in favor,
- 23 say aye.
- 24 (Unanimous aye)

1 MR. DAMSCHRODER: The motion

- 2 carries.
- 3 MR. COLLEY: I have a question.
- Is there a notice sent, advising
- 5 this gentleman that his registration is
- 6 cancelled?
- 7 MR. DAMSCHRODER: We will send
- 8 that notice. All we have is the address
- 9 that we sent the notice to, but we will
- 10 create the record.
- 11 If it is the Board's pleasure
- 12 there are some personnel items that can be
- 13 briefed in executive session that are
- 14 spelled out in the agenda, or we can move
- 15 forward with the agenda.
- 16 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: I don't have
- 17 any problem with anything on there.
- Do you have any problem?
- 19 MR. COLLEY: I don't have a
- 20 problem.
- 21 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: I think we
- 22 will move on if that's okay with
- 23 everybody.
- MR. COLLEY: I have no

- 1 objection.
- 2 MS. PETREE: Do you need to talk
- 3 about anything else?
- 4 MR. DAMSCHRODER: There
- 5 is nothing that we have to discuss.
- 6 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All right
- 7 then. Let's go on and talk about
- 8 personnel matters.
- 9 MR. DAMSCHRODER: There are
- 10 three compensation-related issues. One is
- 11 that as you know we are short a Democrat
- in the Operations Department and, as Denny
- 13 and I have discussed, since we have moved
- 14 operations, the programming portion of the
- 15 operations activities relative to
- 16 programming machines and the ballots, that
- 17 has been moved to the warehouse facility.
- 18 Now, to have a Democrat and Republican
- 19 there all the time so we can have
- 20 equivalency in operations, we have decided
- 21 that we want to cross train Frank Gill,
- 22 who is a Democrat out at the warehouse, in
- 23 the operations area for the programming of
- 24 the database and machines.

1 And we would recommend at this

- 2 time we increase his compensation to
- 3 reflect those additional responsibilities.
- 4 And, depending on how that works out
- 5 training wise and performance wise, we may
- 6 recommend an additional increase sometime
- 7 next year.
- 8 Also Ben Piscitelli, our Public
- 9 Information Officer, when he was hired
- 10 earlier in the year, as part of the
- 11 compensation package we discussed at that
- 12 time we presented a performance-based
- 13 merit structure where, based on his
- 14 performance, we would increase his salary
- 15 by \$5,000 retroactive to his date of hire
- 16 if his performance merited that. I am
- more than pleased with his performance
- 18 thus far.
- As Denny constantly reminds we,
- 20 Ben is the consummate professional. The
- 21 public would probably much rather see his
- 22 face than mine on TV. We are trying to do
- 23 that more and more.
- 24 Also, Kevin Braimer has been a

- 1 regular part-time employee with us for
- 2 several years, actually since sometime
- 3 after the 2004 election, primarily keying
- 4 in voter registration and absentee ballot
- 5 applications.
- 6 He is a great asset to our
- 7 office. He is not a full-time employee
- 8 with benefits, but I would recommend that
- 9 we increase his hourly rate to \$13.75,
- 10 which is slightly less than the hourly
- 11 rate of our lowest paid full-time employee
- 12 in the department. We won't have a
- 13 part-time person making more than a
- 14 full-time person.
- The final item, the
- 16 Commissioners have adopted an employee
- 17 health insurance contribution policy for
- 18 next year. As you recall for '07 they
- 19 began requiring employees to contribute a
- 20 very small amount to their health
- 21 insurance coverage. They would like to
- 22 increase that rate for 2008 to \$35 total
- 23 per month coverage for employees and
- employees with dependent children, and \$85

- 1 total coverage for employees with covered
- 2 spouses irrespective of whether there are
- 3 dependent children involved.
- 4 It's still a great deal. As the
- 5 Commissioners indicated, other
- 6 employees pay 15 percent of their health
- 7 insurance coverage.
- 8 My understanding from that
- 9 document is that the average amount per
- 10 employee per month is \$1,000 that the
- 11 county puts out for all the different
- 12 health insurance benefits, including
- 13 prescription coverage.
- 14 We would recommend that the
- 15 Board as an independent autonomous agency
- 16 request the Commissioners to adopt this
- 17 policy for its employees for next year as
- 18 well.
- 19 If you would like, you can read
- 20 them in individually or read them as one
- 21 resolution, whatever is your pleasure.
- 22 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: I think we
- 23 will do them one at a time.
- 24 First motion is Frank Gill.

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1 MS. MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I
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- 2 move that the Board increase the annual
- 3 compensation of Frank Gill by \$5,000 to
- 4 \$41,641.47 effective immediately.
- 5 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Is there a
- 6 second?
- 7 MS. PETREE: Second.
- 8 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All in favor,
- 9 say aye.
- 10 (Unanimous aye)
- 11 MR. DAMSCHRODER: The motion
- 12 passes.
- 13 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Next one?
- MS. PETREE: Mr. Chairman, I
- 15 move that the Board increase the annual
- 16 compensation of Ben Piscitelli by \$5,000
- to \$60,000 retroactive to his 2007 date of
- 18 hire.
- 19 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Is there a
- 20 second?
- MS. MARINELLO: Second.
- 22 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All in favor,
- 23 say aye.
- 24 (Unanimous aye)

- 1 MR. DAMSCHRODER: The motion
- 2 carries.
- 3 MR. COLLEY: What was his date
- 4 of hire?
- 5 MR. DAMSCHRODER: Sometime in
- 6 February of this year.
- 7 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Kevin
- 8 Braimer?
- 9 MS. MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I
- 10 move that the Board increase the hourly
- 11 rate of Kevin Braimer to \$13.75 per hour
- 12 retroactive to October 1, 2007.
- 13 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Is there a
- 14 second?
- MS. PETREE: Second.
- 16 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All in favor,
- 17 say aye.
- 18 (Unanimous aye)
- 19 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Finally,
- 20 health insurance?
- 21 MS. PETREE: Mr. Chairman, I
- 22 move to adopt the following health
- 23 insurance employee contribution policy for
- 24 Fiscal Year 2008 at the request of the

- 1 Franklin County Commissioners: \$35 total
- 2 per month for coverage of employees and
- 3 employees with dependent children, and \$85
- 4 total per month for coverage of employees
- 5 with covered spouses with no additional
- 6 employee contribution for dependent
- 7 children.
- 8 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Is there a
- 9 second?
- MS. MARINELLO: Second.
- 11 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: All in favor,
- 12 say aye.
- 13 (Unanimous aye)
- 14 MR. DAMSCHRODER: The motion
- 15 carries.
- That is all the business we have
- 17 for the Board today on this special
- 18 meeting.
- 19 CHAIRMAN ANTHONY: Thank you,
- 20 sir.
